## Jersey v England @ Ambassador Hotel, 6th February 2009

The first major event of the bar billiards year was the annual meeting between the **Jersey** and **England** Mens and Ladies teams. In a new venue the Jersey Men were looking to avenge six successive defeats from 2003 (men's match trophy pictured right), the Jersey Ladies were trying to halt run of 12 unsuccessful matches since their last win in 1993.



The Mens match was close at half time with Jersey having a slender 6-5 lead. However Jersey hit form in the 2nd half of the match and ran away 22-11 victors. Congratulations to Jersey captain **Nick Barnett** on his team's fine performance. This was the 28th meeting between the two sides, England lead 18-9 with 1 drawn match. The five best player records from both teams in the international are shown on the left

In the ladies match England won through 12-6, but it was a lot closer than the ladies matches of previous years. **Pauline Withey** was once again the successful England captain and won her 18th match from a ladies record of 21 appearances. England now have won 20 matches to Jersey's 4 wins in the 24 meetings between the two sides.

## Oxfordshire Open @ Didcot Con Club, 21st February

Congratulations to **Tony Martin** (pictured right) who won his first national individual open title at the Oxfordshire Open with victory over Witney's **Tony Willis**. Tony has been a runner up on 3 occasions before, twice in the Mermaid Open (1990 & 1991) and also in the Sussex Open (2004). Tony lost two of those finals the England number 1 and old doubles partner Kevin Tunstall, but got the better of him in their last 16 match this time. Wins then followed against Curt Driver (Kent) and Kevin Hall (Sussex) before beating Tony Willis in the final.

This was Tony Willis' first appearance in a open final, although he did reach the 1998 Bournemouth pairs final with

Jon Bamsey (ironically losing to Tunstall/Martin). He had a great run beating reigning champ Mark Turner and Kent's Peter Sainsbury.

The plate competition was won by 1997 runner up Stuart Giles beating 1998 runner up Paul Sainsbury in the final. The highest break was a 17,770 effort by Kevin Tunstall. Hampshire's Chris Toner made a high ladies break of 3,100
