Apologies for this newsletter being issued a little late but here is the news for March/April 2011. Reports of the Guernsey, Surrey & Sussex Opens will follow in the next newsletter.

In March we all went to the Queens Hotel, Bournemouth for the British Pairs. Steven Sheard added the pairs title to his Oxon Open win in February to continue his fantastic start to the year. He also became the 2nd person after his dad, Keith, to hold the British and World pairs titles simultaneously. Mention should also be given to Steven's partner Pete Philips who played extremely well in the semis and final.



Well done also to our April winners—Leon Beer won his 2nd open title at Portsmouth and Sandra Race took her first national title win taking the British Ladies title held in Horley.

British Pairs @ Queens Hotel, Bournemouth, 12th/13th March 2011

The first weekend in March always sees the bar billiards community travel to Bournemouth for the British Pairs. 53 pairs entered this years event (slightly down on previous years), and **Steven Sheard & Pete Philips** (pictured right) won the pairs together for the first time. The final was a cracker against Oxon's **Tony Willis & Jon Bamsey**. Pete went first and opened with **14,280**. Although they went 2-0 up Steven couldn't finish it off in leg 3, but they were 14,590 up going into leg 4—a target too high for Tony Willis to chase. Steven & Pete had a slight scare in round 3 when Sussex's **Jenny & Pete Edwards** ran them close losing by only 2,020 points. In the semi finals they met former World Pairs champions **Phil Collins & Leon Beer**.



Both Pete (15.060) and Steven (21,200) ran the table out, leaving Leon a too bigger task in the 4th leg needing 22,740 to win. Jon & Tony's run to the final was arguably the tougher, defeating Geoff Powell & Max Dick, Kevin Tunstall & Kevin Hall, reigning champs Keith Sheard & Mark Trafford and then Nigel Senior & Marc Chipman in the semi final. The high breaks were Steven Sheard's 21,200 effort in that semi final and Bella Stoner made a tremendous 12,490 for the high ladies break. In the plate two time winners Paul Sainsbury & Bernie McCluskey beat Buck's Darren Isard & Ray Hussey.

British Ladies, 17th April 2011

Sussex's **Sandra Race** (pictured below, left) has won her first national title, winning the coveted



British Ladies title at the Salfords Club, Horley. Sandra took out reigning champ Alison Norman in the semi finals, and met Surrey's Genette Nicholls in the final. With both players chasing their first major title, judging by the scores it

must have been a nervy affair but Sandra came through 4,440 -3,210. England's numbers 1 & 2, **Pauline Withey** and **Jean Brackenridge** met in a big 1st round clash with Pauline winning through but she succumbed to **Alison Norman** in the Quarter Finals.

2009 champ **Lorraine Hall** (pictured above, right) beat Oxon's **Melissa Standbrige** in the plate final. The high break was made by **Jenny Florey** with **6,020**, although **Melissa Standbridge** made a slightly higher **6,420** in the plate.

Portsmouth Open @ Moneyfields S&S Club, 10th April 2011

Leon Beer (pictured right) won the Portsmouth Open held at the Moneyfield S&S Club defeating Kent's **Curt Driver** (pictured below left) in the final. Leon survived a close game with Mark James in round 3, but followed with fairly comfortable wins against **Ian Moss, Ian Lelliott** and **Martin Smith**. Leon overturned a 1,480 deficit to Curt in leg 1 to finally win 11,430—5,340. This is Leon's 2nd open title adding to his 2010 Sussex Open triumph. Curt was looking



to add to his two titles (winning the 2009 Bucks Open and Grand Prix) but had to be content with runner up this time

Phil Collins won the plate final beating Hampshire's Tony Woolvin. In a day of tough scoring, only 3 breaks over 10k were made the highest being Paul Sainsbury's 14.300. Pauline Withey made the high ladies break of 5,190.
