Berkshire Open @ Post Office Club, Reading, 11th September 2011

### **Kevin Tunstall** (pictured right) won the Berkshire Open for the 6th time. He beat Oxon's **Keith Sheard** in the final. Keith had a



golden chance to win the title, which is one of the only missing from his collection as he was 850 up with his break to come, but he lost his opener and Kevin took the title 17,540-9,760. Kevin had a close game with ladies number 1 Pauline Withey in round 1 (Pauline made the ladies high break in this match of 7,070), and followed with wins over Dave France, Mr Chris Newson, Keith Lewendon and Ian Lelliott in the semi, he also took the high break with 18,550. Dennis Atkins was the other losing semi finalist. Portsmouth Open winner Leon Beer beat **Nigel Senior** in the plate final.


### **AEBBA** Newsletter Editorial

A very busy couple of months in the Bar Billiards calendar has seen Sussex crowned the new county champions, their first win since 2005. Sussex also provided the winner of the All England Team Championships with Kevin Tunstall's New Sussex Hotel retaining their title. A successful couple of months for Kevin as he won the Berkshire Open and Alternative Rules to further extend his lead at the top of the rankings. Curt Driver won the other individual title in October but he won a big one—the All England Singles for the first time, the first winner from Kent since Les Green in  $\bar{1}997$ . Sussex completed the hat-trick of team titles with the ladies winning also. Individually we had (Mrs) Chris Newson winning the All England Ladies for the 7th time (only 3 behind Viv Wright now), and Myra Hawkins showed us that she is still a great player winning the Special Ladies, her first title since the 2006 All England. Well done to all the winners, and we look forward to Jersey with an exciting new format in November.



### County Champs Div 1 @ PO Club, Reading, 25th Sept 2011

Sussex A won the county championship title—they had last won it in 2005. The winning side was Nigel Senior (captain), Barry Holt, Ian Lelliott, Gareth Lloyd, Kevin Tunstall, Martin Smith and Richard Wooton. The format has changed from previous years with 6 teams playing in division 1 and the other teams playing in division 2 in November. This made for an interesting day, with Sussex, Berkshire, Oxon A and Kent all in contention until the final series of games. In the first series, it was the dominant side over



series 2 Sussex A recovered to take a 6-1 over Hants, Oxon A took a 4-3 win over Berks to join Sussex at the top with 9 points. In series 3, Sussex A and Oxon A recorded 4-3 wins (over Berks and Hants) to stay level on 13 points, Kent stayed within range with a 4-3 win over Oxon B to move to 11 points. The 4th series saw momentum shift to Sussex as while they were beating Oxon B 5-2, Berks pulled off a bit of a shock to beat Oxon A 5-2. With one

game left, Sussex led by 3, from Berks and Oxon A, with Kent 1 point behind. Sussex won their last match against Oxon A by an incredible 6-1, Berks beating Kent 5-2 to take 2nd place. Hants took a crucial 4-3 win against Oxon B to relegate the B side. Three players were unbeaten on the day, Sussex captain Nigel Senior and Berkshire's Paul Sainsbury and Bernie McCluskey. Oxon's Leon Beer did have the only 10k+ average with 10,348. Mark Trafford made the days high break of 17,460.

Special Ladies @ PO Club, Reading, 23rd October 2011

Myra Hawkins (pictured right) won the Special Ladies for the first time beat Oxon's Jenny Florey in a



close final 5,870-4,740. 16 ladies entered the event this year, and Myra started with a win over fellow Berkshire player Janet Burns. In the Quarter Finals she came from behind to beat British Ladies champ Sandra Race. Denise Wills was Myra's semi final victim. Jenny had a great run to the final including a win over ladies number 1 Pauline Withey in the semi final. Myra took the high break with 6,360. Janet Burns did go on to win the plate, beating Sussex's Ros Appleby.

Chris Newson (pictured right) won her 7th All England Ladies title (her 3rd win in 4 years) heating Surrey's **Denise Wills** in the final. Chris won a tough group with Berks' Myra Hawkins, and Oxon's Pauline Withey plus Sussex's Colleen Park. Denise overcame Jackie Peckham (Kent) and Sue Haberman (Bucks). In the final Chris took a 1,170 lead



into leg 2, and ran out the winner 7,970-4,680. Myra Hawkins made the days high break of 6,480



### Ladies County Champs @ Post Office Club, Reading, 2nd October 2011

Sussex A retained the ladies county championship. It was their 8th win out of the last 11 years. It was an incredibly close contest, with Sussex, Oxon and Surrey all in contention until the final series of games. After 5 of the 6 series Oxon led Surrey and Sussex by 1 point and looked favourites as they were playing Berkshire in the last game, but as they slipped to a 3-2 defeat, Sussex beat Surrey by 3-2, Bella Stoner taking the crucial last leg against Alison Norman, a leg which at the time would give either team the title. Sussex finished level with Oxon on 16 points but took the title on number of match wins (4 to Oxon's 3). Sussex's Jan Btihell was

Geoff Jukes & Kevin Hall won for the New Sussex Hotel but Keith Lewendon and Bernie McCluskey won for the Berks side to make the score 2-2. Kevin Tunstall took first go in the final leg and made 20,050 (highest break of the day) and Paul Sainsbury broke down 14,150 in reply. The Sussex side came through a tough group with Oxon's Kennington CC running them close beating them 3-2, but New Sussex did enough in their other matches. Kevin overcame last years runner up Mark Trafford in a repeat of last years final in the semi final. Sonia McIntyre was the other losing semi finalist—a great achievement by a lady player to reach that stage of a national event. Another lady, Carla Jolly won the plate beating (Mr) Chris Newson. 38 players turned out for the unique event where 6 white balls are placed in a triangle at the back of the table to

start the game. Everytime the balls are cleared the triangle is reformed. This results on lower scores than we usually see - Kevin Tunstall made the day's highest break of 1,700.
