The men's International kicked off the bar billiards year in February. It was a convincing win for England who triumphed 25-8 over the Jersey. Unfortunately Jersey sent no ladies side for the 2nd time running which gives concerns over the future of this fixture.

The first open was held in Oxon, it was won by Phil Collins who beat the top 3 in the rankings, Kevin Tunstall, Nigel Senior and Steven Sheard onhis way to the title. A great return to form for Phil. A quick word for Steven also who has been in incredible form reaching 5 finals since last years Oxon open win, and has now gone to a new personal high of number 2 in the rankings.



We have a lot to look forward to in the coming months—in March we have the British Pairs in Bournemouth, which I am sure will be a fantastic weekend as it always is.

England Men v Jersey Men @ Ardington Hotel, 4th February 2012

The first major event of the bar billiards year was the annual meeting between the **England** (pictured right) and **Jersey** Men's teams. Played at the Ardington Hotel, Worthing, England were looking continue their recent good run over Jersey

The draw threw up some interesting matches as Jersey sent over a stronger side than they have in recent years. Although Jersey made a poor start losing the first 3 legs, they battled back well to share the next 8 games to be only

7-4 down at the half-way stage. For the England side **Paul Sainsbury, Kevin Tunstall &** Leon Beer hit 10k scores in their first leg.

England took command in the 2nd half of the match as the bonus point for the aggregate kicked in. Only **Dennis Helleur (3-0 v Tony Woolvin)** and **Dave Gallichan (2-1 v Martin Smith)** could hold on to aggregate wins for Jersey, as 9 England players completed aggregate wins in the 2nd half of the match. This made the final scoreline **25-8**. Of those 9 wins, six were 3-0 wins and they were achieved by **Curt Driver, Nigel Senior, Steven Sheard, Paul Sainsbury, Kevin Tunstall & Leon Beer**. A very strong performance by England who will look forward to their next tests against Guernsey away in May and Jersey away next February.

Oxfordshire Open @ Didcot Con Club, 18th February 2012

Phil Collins (pictured right) won the first national open of the year by winning the 2012 Oxfordshire Open. Phil had been runner up in the last 2 years but went one better this time to win his first home open. This is Phil's 8th national title.

Phil beat the top 3 ranked players on his way to the title, he beat England number 1 Kevin Tunstall in round 2 (chasing down 18,760 with a 19,690 run out). In the semi final he beat number 2 Nigel Senior in a very close match where Phil made 9k at the death to win by 1,250. In the final he beat number 3 and defending champion Steven Sheard 17,260—520. For



Steven this was his 5th runner up in a national individual event since last years Oxon Open win (losing 3 finals to Kevin Tunstall and 2 to Phil). Steven made safe passage to the final and met former champion **Tony Martin** in the semi final, winning fairly comfortably 11,500 to 4,440.



The plate was won by Hampshire's **Barry Radford** (pictured left) who beat **Bert Lovegrove** in the final. Bert had a good day, especially as he gave England player **Leon Beer** a big scare in round 1 after being 14k up after the 1st leg, Leon made a good comeback with a 16,990 break. There were 8 recorded breaks over 15k on the day, the highest of which being Phil's **19,690** in beating Kevin. The ladies high break went to **Pauline Withey** with **5,290**.

Greatest matches in National Tournaments (part 2)

Part 2 of the greatest matches in national tournaments looks at the highest 2 leg scores inflicted on poor opponents. A certain K.Sheard has inflicted a 40k+2 leg score 19 times on poor opponents! Here are the top 2 leg scores (over 45k), headed by Mark Sawyers incredible 53,670 at the 1999 Oxon Open

- 3) K.Sheard v T.Webster 46,410 1,150 (Oxon Open'99)

- 5) K.Sheard v D.Flattery 45,610 450 (Grand Prix '03)
- 6) K.Sheard v R.Langlois 45,400 510 (International '94)
- 7) K.Sheard v M.Lingham 45,270 660 (Kent Classic '97)
- 8) K.Sheard v P.Phillips 45,220 890 (Oxon Open '95)

Other players to have hit 40k are K.Tunstall (43,640), C.Reeves (41,950), P.Collins (41,180), P.Farrelly (41,070), K.Clark (41,010), N.Senior (40,570) & J.Burrows (40,470). The highest score in the World Champs is Steve Ahier's 27,850 in the 1991 tournament.
