AEBBA Newsletter Editorial

The bar billiards year started with a disappointment as the men's International was cancelled as Jersey could not field a side. This is the first time the match has been cancelled since it started in 1981. Lets hope the match is played in Jersey next year and the future of the match continues.

The first open of the year was held in Oxon, it was won by **Dave Ingram** who won his first national title.

We have a lot to look forward to in the coming months—in March we have the British Pairs in Bournemouth, which I am sure will be a fantastic weekend as it always is. We also have the 2nd East Anglian Open, in Sudbury, which was great fun last year playing the 4 pin version of the game.



Oxfordshire Open @ Didcot Con Club, 8th February 2014

Dave Ingram (pictured right) won his first national individual title by winning the 2014 Oxfordshire Open. Dave beat fellow Sussex player **Ian Lelliott** in the final. A 6k lead in leg 1 was added to with a 7k opening break in leg 2 to give him an unassailable lead.

Dave was fairly untroubled en route to the quarter finals where he met **Curt Driver** who set him a 17k target, which Dave beat with 18k. Dave then won a very tight semi final against the much improved **Colin Southouse** by just **390** points **13,470-13,080**. Ian had a tough route to the final. In round 2 he had to knock his **first ever 20k break** to beat **Richard Wooton's** 19k. He was then 8k down against **Phil Osborne** but won

with an 11k 2nd leg score. **Geoff Jukes** set him 16k in the quarters but Ian again chased down the score with 18k. A reasonably comfortable win against **Gerry Fitzjohn** in the semi final put Ian in the final.

It was a day of high scores and terrific matches. **Phil Collins** made an amazing **24,730** (high break of the day) against **Paul Sainsbury** in round 1, Paul came back with a great **21,050** in reply. Phil then made **22,640** to beat **Kevin Tunstall's 19,080** in round 2. Phil looked unbeatable but **Pete Sainsbury** stopped him in the next round after an early mistake from Phil was punished. In all there were **five** 20k+ breaks and no less than **36** 10k+ breaks.

Paul Sainsbury went on to win the plate beating **Damian Coates** in the final. **Pauline Withey** recorded the ladies high break of 6,810 and along with **Dawn Jordan** reached the last 16 to be furthest ladies. Thanks to **Mark Trafford**, **Tony Willis** and **Pete Ewins** for organising the day.

Bar Billiard Variants

99% of the time we play normal 3 pin bar billiards. One common variant is off the spot. More recently we have had a 4 pin open where the pins are placed in different positions than usual and of course there is an extra one. The other national title we play is the Alternative, or triangle rules. But there are a few more obscure ones that I have come across.

Thirty-Ones—each player must score 310 points exactly on each visit followed by a legal shot. A point is scored for each successful turn. Sometimes the rules mean you move to 32 once you get 31 and so on.

Killer—can be played with a deck of cards. Each player starts with 6 lives, turns over a card and has to pot that amount of balls to keep their life. If a Jack is turned the player must pot a 10, Queen a 100 and King a 200.

Chase the Red—play is normal but player must hit the red first on every shot. Also the break shot is not the normal break shot but you start with the red behind the 10 hole, and any time the table is cleared you put the red back behind the 10 hole. Think it is normally played off the spot, but guess it doesn't have to be.

Tactics— Cue ball always played off the spot. Red Ball break position half way between 100 and 200 holes. Cue ball must hit a cushion before hitting another ball!!
