#### Guernsey v England, 7th March 2015

The first six singles matches went 14-4 to England—Ian Champion doing well to get a match win for Guernsey. Now the score was 33-5 and the match result was beyond doubt. Sadly for Guernsey the last 5 singles followed a similar pattern with a 14-1 scoreline. This made the final score 47-6.

In March we all went to the Queens Hotel, Bournemouth for the British Pairs. **Leon Beer & Phil Collins** won the title for the 2nd time together.

We also had the third 4 pin open in Sudbury. It was a great to see our new friends who play a very different version of the game—congrats to **Mal Spier** on his first national win.

Two opens were also played **Mark Trafford** showed he is now a very top player taking another title winning in Surrey—but for me the highlight was **Gary Powell**, who, I think it is fair to say has always been dangerous but hadn't looked like winning a big title, winning the Oxon Open. His efforts to beat **Mark Trafford & Phil Collins**—then making a PB in chasing **Kevin Tunstall**—fantastic!



The first weekend in March always sees the bar billiards community travel to Bournemouth for the British Pairs. 54 pairs entered this years event, **Leon Beer & Phil Collins** (pictured right) won the British pairs together for the second time. The final was against last years winners **Curt Driver & Mark Brewster**. Leon opened with 16k to take the first leg. Curt missed early in leg 2, allowing Leon and Phil to be 2-0 up and 24k up at half time. Phil finished the job off by going off with enough in leg 3. Phil also made the 4 highest breaks in the competition—two over 20k, but it also has to be said that Leon played his part with a big contribution when the matches went to 4 legs from the semis.



Leon & Phil started off with potentially a tough match against four-time runners-up Tony Willis & Jon Bamsey—but Phil made an incredible 23,110 break at

10am which was never going to be caught! They then beat Bucks pair Ernie Jordan & Ray Hussey, before playing Paul Sainsbury & Bernie McCluskey in the last 16. Phil came back with 18,690 after being set 14k. A 20,510 opener from Phil ended Pete Sainsbury & Mike Callanan's hopes in the quarters and they beat 2011 champs Steven Sheard & Pete Phillips in 3 legs in the semi final.

Curt & Mark made comfortable passage to the quarter finals where they met surprise package **Myra Hawkins & Janet Burns**. They were 3k down here but came back to win the 2nd leg by 9k. They were then 2-0 down against **Kevin Tunstall & Kevin Hall** in the semi finals but

came back to win the last 2 legs and take the aggregate win 39,030-17,660.

Phil Osborne & Colin Southouse won the plate competition with a 3-1 win over Chris Saville & Tony Maretin in the final. Janet Burns made the high ladies break 5,890 in that quarter final. As usual a great weekend, contact Dave Ingram if you want to play next year!


#### 2nd East Anglian 4 Pin Open, Sudbury, 21st March 2015

Mal Spier (pictured right) won the 3rd East Anglian 4 pin open held at the Grover & Allen pub in Sudbury. Mal beat Curt Driver in the final. It was a close final where Mal had to sink the last ball to win by just 110 points



48 players entered the open 24 from the local leagues in Suffolk and Norfolk, 24 regulars from the 3 pin circuit. The players were split into groups of 3, top two progressing to the main comp, the other eliminated into the plate.

Mal made it through his group unbeaten. 2 players scored over 10k in their group games (4 legs)—reigning champ Nigel Senior (15,060) and top local player Geoff Bridges (11,060). Mal met Nigel in the quarter finals winning a close match 2,380-1,920. All other quarter finalists were 3 pin players. Mal beat  ${f Simon~Coleman}$

# Surrey Open @ St Nicholas' School, Merstham, 12th April 2015

Mark Trafford (pictured right) has won Surrey Open title. He beat Berkshire's Paul Sainsbury in the final. Mark had a 6k lead going into leg 2 and ran out a comfortable winner 16,070-3,760.

After a 1st round bye, Mark beat Jason Wadsworth in round 2, but **Tony Jenner** proved a tricky opponent in round 3. Tony looked like he was going to chase down a 12k lead only to miss late on—Mark sunk the 200 to win (at this point you could have

engraved his name on the trophy!). Mark then overcame Colin Robbins, Curt Driver and Glenn Chubb to make the final.

Paul beat Nev Blackman in round 1. Dave Jones (Surrey) provided a tough test in round 2 but Paul came through 14,440-11,190. Wins over Terry Oakley, Geoff Jukes and Martin Smith followed and an 18k play out put out Keith Sheard in the semis.

Damian Coates finally won a plate final beating Genette Nicholls. Pauline Withey took the highest ladies break with 8,490 and she and Michelle Baden were the furthest ladies all reaching the last 16. Keith Sheard had the days high break with 19,030.
