1987 runner-up Kevin Tunstall lost the toss and was put in to take first break. Although he made a mistake at 6320, hitting the split-shot too thick, Kevin sailed on to a 15,290 break to the bar in 16½ minutes. They each felled a pin, then Graham scored 100, allowing Kevin to pot the last ball for another 100.

The 1982 champion, who has now reached the last 16 on six occasions, needed almost 1000 per minute, but was only up to 4570 in 7 minutes when he allowed Kevin back. 2920 in the next three minutes assured the England captain his biggest accolade of a wonderful career. Graham made another 2470 but Kevin finished it off with another 3360 and Graham conceded.

The left-hander is a 48-year-old who has been playing since 1959. He is a printer who plays for the La Marquanderie at St Brelade's.

He had reached 8540 in plenty of time, but went out of position and seemed to try to double a ball back into the 100. FAR TOO HARD was the jury's decision as it marmellised the black pin at 75 mph....Tunstall conceded at that point.

WHAT HAPPENED AT THE A.G.M.

Held at the Blue Flag, Cadmore End, near Stokenchurch, Bucks on Sunday Dec 12th. The three-hour meeting was not attended by four counties who all sent apologies: Leics, Somerset, South Yorks and Wilts.

Due to an administration error, the Romans (Sussex), who should have played the Lion in the final of the Team Championships in November, were given free passage into the 1994 event, but not at the expense of any other Sussex team.

PROPOSALS ACCEPTED WERE....

British Open Pairs semifinals will now be over 4 legs, as in the final.

All references to "him" or "his" in the rules would be changed to refer to males AND females whenever a major re-print of the rules becomes necessary.

Ladies Open GRAND PRIX points will now be 8 for the winner, 5 for runner-up, 3 for losing semifinalist and 1 for losing quarterfinalist.

List of criteria to decide positions in seeded list for GRAND PRIX FINALS:

- (i) Grand Prix points gained throughout the series for the current year
- (ii) If equal, the number of EVENTS a player has qualified for GRAND PRIX TOUR points shall be the deciding factor (this would benefit a more consistent player rather than benefit a player who only produces one good event)
- (iii) If still equal, the number of MATCHES a player has WON in all GRAND PRIX TOUR events throughout the year
- (iv) If still equal, the number of GRAND PRIX TOUR events a player has played in throughout the year (this would benefit the keener player)
- (v) If still equal, a toss or draw will be made with winner CHOOSING position in the seeded list. If, however, this would be critical to decide whether a player qualifies for the last 16 or not, the only possible fair solution would be to arrange a play-off.

Non-appearance of any player in the top 16:

In the case of an English player not participating, the reserve list would be called upon to fill that position in the list.

If a Jersey player decides not to travel, the whole seeded list would "squeeze" up and allow reserves into the list at the bottom.
