THE FINALISTS

Kevin Clark was 26 one week after the Heineken Open and has been playing for about 9 years. He reached the semifinals of last year's Berkshire Open which was only 3 weeks after making his England debut.

He is a sales assistant with a builders' merchants and lives in Rochester. He plays for the Good Intent in his home town and has won many local honours in the Medway league, representing Kent on "7 or 8" occasions.

Pete Phillips is not so well known on the circuit, although he did reach the last 32 in Jersey in 1991. He is a youthful 32 and has been playing about 6 years.

He plays at the Tandem in his hometown Kennington, in both the Eynsham and Oxford leagues. He was recently drafted into the Eynsham Area side. Like Kevin, he is not married and is a fork-lift truck driver.

He is surely set to improve on his current ranking of 237, 225 places below Kevin. Yet, he should have been knocked out in the first round when Surrey's John Keen lost a winning break at the end of the second leg.

THE FINAL

Kevin lost the toss and was asked to take first break. He pined out on his first split shot and Pete only followed up with 40. Kevin made a shaky 130 and then both failed to score on their next visit.

Both were playing the biggest game of their lives and both were very nervous.

Pete was the first to settle with a good 9850 break although one shot whipped out of the 100 hole at 2500 and he was a little lucky to carry on.

12½ minutes were now gone and Kevin still only managed another 110 for a grand total so far of 240. When Pete followed up with another 3580, it looked all over.

Kevin suddenly seemed to get going. A 1770 last-gasp break still left him 2010 - 13470 behind with Pete's break to come in the 2nd leg.

Pete openly confidently with another 2370 but, after touching a pin, seemed glad to get off. Kevin needed 14000 in 15 minutes, a target usually within his capabilities, but he looked defeated when he only made 80. Pete still looked in charge when he only made another 100, but the amended target was now 14000 in 14 minutes and, as the saying goes, "When the going gets tough, the tough get going".

14 minutes later, Kevin had made a 16,250 break to confound most of the crowd, and delight the strong Kent contingent.

Perhaps, after this glowing report, he will subscribe to BBQ....ed.

THE FINALISTS

Paul Sainsbury is a 35 year-old dealer accountant from Andover, Hants, although he now plays for Berkshire since moving from Kent a few years ago. His only previous Open title win was in his home town some years ago. He plays his league games at the Bird-in-Hand in Tilehurst in the Reading league. His biggest national successes were the All-England Championship in 1986 and the British Open Pairs in 1989 with Viv Wright.

His most difficult match was in the third round against Keith Sheard. Paul knew he had to play out the entire first leg to give him a chance. He reached 20,110 but left Keith a shot at the last ball 100. Keith chased in typical fashion, but was still over 600 short when the bar dropped. He seemed to have calculated superbly, but missed the 200 hole which would have won it by just 10.

Paul was then informed by scorer Bernie McCluskey that he had won and took the 100 very casually. Luckily for him (and Bernie) it went down as Keith could still have won it with a second go.

Sean Taylor has really come to the fore recently. After losing to McCluskey in the final of the "Off-the-Spot" in October, he beat Mark Turner in the final of the Under-22 championship in November. This performance must now improve his status at the top level.

Sean is only 21 but has been playing for about 6 years. He is a buyer who plays for the Bull Inn at Hastings, his home town. He reckons he has never gone past the second round of any previous Open.

THE FINAL

Paul lost the toss but proceeded to play out the first leg for a 19,320 break in 17½ minutes.

Sean, spurred on by Julian Deeprouse of course, seemed well on target with 3990 in 3½ minutes but then, perhaps rushing too much, he missed his shot and Paul was back.

He failed to clinch the match initially but Sean could not get the break back and Paul then returned for another 10,420 break and then yet another 1980.

Lewendon's reply was only 5640 but the Eynsham number 7 could not settle. When Lewendon lost a break of nearly 2000 which would have clinched the title, Sturgess was given one last chance of 5000 in the last 4 minutes, but he was off the table very quickly and Reading took the title for the fourth successive year.
