THE SEMI'S Jan made breaks of 3780 and 8300 in the first leg, and Gail was always struggling after she lost her opening 700 in the second leg. She did manage a 3450 break but never in contention.

A 7000 each in the first leg left Pauline just 320 down with Alison's break to follow. Nerves showed in the 2nd leg but Alison eventually made a 3490 break and then another 1410 before Pauline's 4840 made it very close again. Pauline's short one-up shot allowed Alison in but she missed the break shot. Her vital 650 left Pauline just too much adrift.

THE FINAL Jan missed her first one-up and Alison made 2480 before pushing a ball off the 50 pocket into the middle of the table. Jan pinned her shot and

Alison made another 3430. Two more visits by Jan and then Alison made another 2800. Jan's final 1650 gave her a good solid practice for the second leg. Alison's 6620 lead with his break to come seemed sufficient until she had her first one-up bounce out. Jan only replied with 550 but Alison could only score 130 when she seemed to have it in the bag. Jan, now 6650 behind with 14 minutes left, showed enormous determination with a 10,270 break. Alison needed 3620 in less than 1½ minutes.

**GRAND PRIX TOUR 1994: LATEST STANDINGS**

With 7 of the nine events played (only the Wessex and Jersey to count), here is the latest standings for this year's Grand Prix tour. The top 16 at the end of the series will be invited to play in the Grand Prix Finals at Ascot on November 26th, for the big prize money. Normal points awarded for Grand Prix events are W 15, Ru 10, Sf 6 (or 7/5 if third-place match played), Qf 3, Last 16 1. Ladies Open points are: W 8, Ru 5, Sf 3, Qf 1. British Isles Open points are: W 20, Ru 15, 3rd 10, 4th 8, Qf 6, Last 16 3, Last 32 1. Criteria to decide seeded list if any positions are level:

- i) The number of events a player has qualified for GPT points.
- ii) The number of matches a player has won in GPT events during the year.
- iii) The number of GPT events a player has played in during the year.
- iv) Draw lots with winner CHOOSING the desired position in the list. BUT IF THIS IS CRITICAL to decide whether a player qualifies for the top 16, a play-off must be arranged.

Notes: If any English player from the top 16 does not arrive for the Finals, a player from the reserves will be called upon to fill the vacant position. If a Jersey player from the top 16 decides not to travel to the event, the whole seeded list will squeeze up and allow reserves into the bottom of the top 16.
