Yeo beat Bamsey against the break but McCluskey's opening 2000 was hardly enough against Tunstall and it was 1-1.

Bucks were happy until Berks won the next three legs. Only two more required... Walsh played the table out against Sheard for the highest break of the division, but Turner could not take advantage on an early slip by Dick, and Bucks were home.

After Jersey's points are added (i.e. Winner 20, runner-up 15, third 10, fourth 8, qtr-finalists 6, last 16 3 and last 32 1) the top 16 will be invited to play in the Grand Prix Finals on Saturday evening, November 26th (new venue to be advised). A dress code for semifinalists will be required.

The following criteria decides placings if any players are level on Grand Prix Pts:

- the number of events a player has qualified for Grand Prix Points in 1994
- the number of matches a player has won in Grand Prix events in 1994
- the number of Grand Prix events a player has played in during 1994
- players still equal will draw to choose their desired position in the list. However, drawing lots to decide whether any player qualifies for the top 16 or not, will not be allowed, in which case a play-off will be arranged.

Note that, if any English-based player from the top 16 does not arrive for the event, a player from the reserves will be called upon to fill the vacant position. But if a JERSEY player from the top 16 decides not to travel to the event, the whole seeded list will be re-written, allowing the reserves into the bottom of the list.

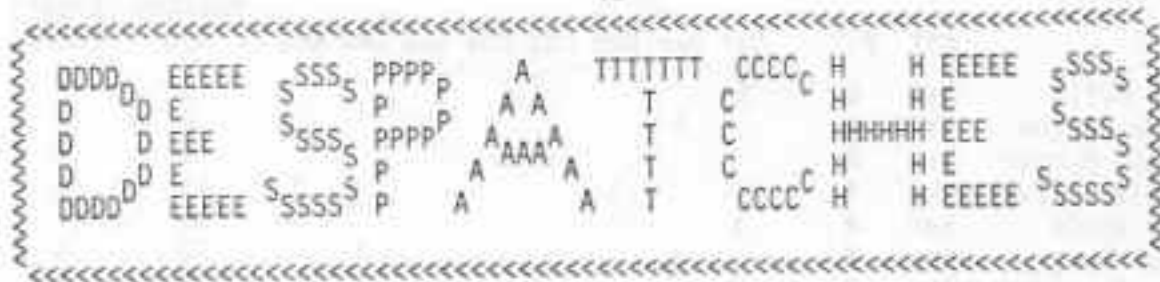
With the 14th Jersey Championship now upon us, let us look at how players have performed over the years.
