NEWS FROM THE A.G.M.

The entire meeting was saddened by the news that President Norrie Lambert was now in hospital and "very poorly".

The Treasurer reported a loss of £165 on the year, and urged that new ways of raising funds be introduced swiftly, especially now that each event at the Royal Berks Hosp SC would cost an extra £25 to stage. It was agreed that (a) county affiliation fees would double to £20 per year and (b) admission to events would double to £2, although this would replace the requirement to donate raffle prizes.

Phil Hawkins offered to purchase decent prizes in future for each event, paid from the expected increased funds. It was hoped that, in the case of those leagues who paid for the donated prizes, they would now pay at least half the admission charges for the players.

The loss of Somerset and South Yorks this year was much regretted.

The rejection of bar billiards being recognised by the Sports Council was also regretted. It was said to be on the grounds of insufficient physical effort being required. "What is the difference between us and sports like pool and snooker, both of which are fully recognised".

It was very pleasing to hear from Guernsey Secretary NORMAN WILKINSON, suggesting three-cornered Internationals in future and asking for the same affiliation advantages enjoyed by Jersey. This was agreed.

It was agreed that, where possible, it should become the norm to brush all tables between each match in All-England events.

Dave Barnes was elected to the Committee as Assistant Secretary as the first process in grooming him to succeed Eric in due course. Kevin Tunstall will continue to serve as an officer on the executive. All other officers were returned en bloc.

The selection committee for the coming year will be: E Hill, K Lewendon, P Withey, K Tunstall, P Farrelly, S Tinto, C Saville, M Hawkins and S Mariner.

As K MacDonald and B McCluskey had withdrawn, D Barnes and C Newson were elected in their stead, giving 11 in all.

Peter Farrelly stated BBQ subs would not be increased this year despite extra expenses being incurred. More events created more work, more photos, more reports to be written, more printing cassettes to be used, etc. He suggested that Jersey and Guernsey be invited to take part in the County and Team championships as fully affiliated members, eventually enabling the National Rankings to be made British or even World Rankings.



Pete also said he was pleased how *POT BLACK MAGAZINE* reports were being accepted in full with very little editing. Next month would see the first **THREE** page report. It had created interest worldwide, with letters being received from such distant destinations as **SUNNY** Manchester and **WET** Ibiza. It can only be good for the game.

On the subject of the *DR MARTENS OPEN*, Pete had arranged a 10% discount to anyone wishing to book their hotel room early, assuming ten rooms could be booked within a few weeks. (3 are so far booked, so anyone wanting top class accommodation in June for the event of the year, please ring Pete as soon as possible).
