THE FINAL

Keith was clearly chasing his first Open title from the start of the day, actually registering TEN big breaks during the event, EIGHT of them over 18,500. He lost the toss and played out the first leg of the final, but not as quickly as he would have liked. Kevin obviously did not relish having to go any faster, and never seemed to be on course. He was still nearly 3500 adrift with only two minutes remaining when he played the "split" shot too thick and failed to get the break back. Keith was relieved to get another chance, making a further 2330 break to earn the £800 prize.

Keith found himself slipping down the rankings abruptly at the end of last season, and answered this by winning the first major of the 1995 season.

No one can deny that he earned it, after so many near misses, in singles and double events

SESSION ONE: Green trailed on the first leg but stormed home with a 10,400 break in the second. Farrelly played it cagey, slowing the game down when a ball rested on the pin early in the first leg. It stopped Marett having a chance of a go at the break and one-up, but he still started the second leg with about 2,500. Farrelly rallied with 2 breaks around 2,000 each. Walsh's nose bleed just before the match probably contributed to his form.

SESSION TWO: Ahier's 7,760 break in the second leg secured victory, but Noel was never in touch with Sainsbury who put England 3-2 ahead with a 7250 2nd leg break.

SESSION THREE: Here is where the match was won. Millward never in danger with a fine return to the England side after an 11-year gap, making a 6310 break in the first leg. Aiming carefully, but obviously not accurately, Tinto's shot hit the 100 hole at speed. His supporters held their breath and the prayers were answered. The ball whipped out of the hole and on to the waiting ball. Not only did he hit the ball....he scored from it. Tinto was "quite relieved" and he clinched the game. England were 5-2 ahead, just one more to win.

SESSION FOUR: Festou remained unbeaten in his 3 Internationals with breaks of 6,910 in the first leg and 8,930 in the second. Tunstall trailed on the first leg by 1,450 but he can be counted upon to turn it on for victory.

SESSION FIVE: Sheard had already lost about 7,000 in the first leg so was confident at being able to do it all again in the second. Jeanne's late 5,830 was always running out of time. Barbet was not happy with his table, but the 450 deficit was not big enough to worry him. He has the best Jersey record by far, winning 7 of his 8 matches.

ROUND-UP: Only four England players and two Jersey players won both their legs. Farrelly, Sainsbury, Millward and Sheard for England.....Douglas, Ahier and Festou for Jersey.

As well as Kevin Clark dropping out of the team, Mick Lingham and Mark Brewster both declined the position of reserve, Dennis Athins taking that honour.

Charlie Wheeler has decided to retire for the last time at the end of this season, after 45 years in the game. He first played at Wheatley in Oxfordshire in January 1950, and, a month later, made his league debut for the Wynford Arms at Reading's TUC club. He was 960 behind at the bar and scored 1080 to win.

He became captain of the team the following season, and it took five years to win the Challenge Cup TWICE. When he became Reading Secretary, he built the league into three divisions.

By the 1960's he was winning everything and only lost twice in 126 matches over a three-year period, becoming Inter-Area captain.

The best game he played in was a defeat. Charlie opened with 9,680 against World Turned Upside Down landlord Dennis Oxlade, but was beaten by 180. The game cost 6d at that time, and it lasted 21 minutes.... great value for money!

In the middle of the 1970-71 season, Charlie and his wife Lily were seriously injured in a road accident at Weedon (Northants) but he fought back, despite having to wear a corset support, but by 1973 he was living in Doncaster and travelled to Bourne (round trip 75 miles) to continue his career. Later moving to Rushden, he played with Farrelly and Biggs at the Waggon and Horses. The following season, he captained the pub's B team, despite moving back to Doncaster and having to make a 210-mile trip to play every week.

But his methods did not suit the B team players and he decided to form a Doncaster league from scratch, having Tarratt tables installed all over the area.

In the summer of 1986, he won all seven trophies available to him. He retired in 1990 but then decided to carry on, and won the league twice more. He has pledged to keep in touch with the news through the BBQ.
