Tunstall opened with 16,110 in the first 13 minutes, and then surprisingly missed. Moquet came straight back to get another swift 6,700. Moquet had blown it when he had opened with 5,500 in the second leg, but he was already behind the clock. Tunstall scored 195,750 in his 14 legs, averaging 13.982 during the tournament.

THE SEMI-FINALS

The Oxford boys won the toss and with Moquet opening with 12,890, they won the first leg 13,640 - 910. Sawyer pinned his first effort in leg 2 but Sheard did not score and then Blain made a 4,130 break, although he was lucky to keep it when he had a ball go round the back of the 50 on the one-up and it rested on the pin. Moquet cleared it heroically and made a 11,270 to go 2-0 up. Sheard finally got on the score-sheet with a 3,300 opener to leg 3 but Sawyer replied with 8,320. Moquet made it close with a late 3,910, but Blain had to open leg 4 needing 18,800 to win on aggregate. He pinned but Moquet made nothing and Sawyer scored only 120 before Sheard made absolutely sure with 5,510. Moquet chipped in with 4,780 later.

Put in the take first break, Tunstall only opened leg 1 with 3,180 and did not know at that stage that he would only score a further 510 in seven further visits in the whole match. It mattered not! Powell answered with 2,650 and then Dick followed up with breaks of exactly 5,000 and 2,000 to take the first leg against the break. Dick had the chance of making it 2-0 but only started with 4,770 and then Martin made a winning 11,370. It was 1-1 with Dick/Powell leading by just 670. Martin only made 1,280 at the start of leg 3 but then made another 8,310 on his 2nd visit and they led 2-1 and by 6,070. Powell seemed on course in the 4th leg but slipped up at 4,580. Tunstall and Dick messed up also and Martin sealed it all with a telling 9,080.
