THE AMAZING FACTS OF THE LAST EVENT

Just some of the amazing statistics of surely the best-ever line-up in the quarter-finals of ANY Open event:

- (1) SEVEN of the eight sections in the draw were won by the top-ranked player in that section. (Only Tony Walsh failed...and his section was won by Bernie McCluskey, who was probably not a bad substitute).
- (2) SIX of the top nine in the rankings were in the quarter-final line-up. With Paul Sainsbury and Steve Mariner not entering, again only Tony Walsh was unlucky. Add No.13 Mick Lingham and No.18 Bernie McCluskey to that.
- (3) ALL the last eight have won tournaments previously, ranging from Tunstall's 18 to Lingham's solitary All-England Individual.
- (4) SIX of the last eight have won ten All-England titles between them,*eleven British Open Pairs titles, eight Off-the-Spot titles, three Jersey Opens, 22 Opens in England and 2 Grand-Prix finals, plus a small matter of 62 full England caps.
- (5) The highest-scoring National final, unless anyone knows different.

.....And, for good measure, the highest break (26,400) in any National event.
 So, although due to withdrawal of the main sponsors for this year it was never going to be the BIGGEST ever event, it was CERTAINLY THE BEST.

THE TRULY AMAZING FINAL

John lost the toss and proceeded to rattle up a phenomenal 23,630 break. Keith had already made breaks of 26,400, 22,700 and 24,350, the latter proving too much for holder Tunstall. So, this would probably be within his reach. It certainly looked easy as Keith seemed set for at least 25,000, but then played a slow split shot to leave the ball hanging over the 100 hole. After gathering his thoughts, the unlucky Oxford milkman hit the ball but left both balls up, and John returned for the most important 530 points of his day, if not his life. The prize belonged to the current All-England champion.
