A VERY, VERY EXCITING FINAL throughout. Don lost his initial break of 2,840, hopefully not too perturbed by a vandal breaking a wall-light fitting just behind the table. *"Actually, your honour, it was an accident, and I was only trying to get a better look at the match"*. Terry only scored 40 and then another 120 when Don failed to score again. Don lost another small break and Terry added 30 to his score. Don pinned again and Terry made 230 to go 420 - 0 ahead after a whole ten minutes play. Don finally made 50 and Terry added 180. Don missed again and Terry scored 140 on his 6th visit. Don retrieved the break back at 14 minutes and made an important 1,920 to win the first leg by 1,230.

Terry threw away his opener of around 1,000 by missing a ball between the 30 and 20 holes, but Don fouled also. Terry made 50 and 20 around a 210 from Don. But then both failed to score as the balls congregated on the table. Don seemed to have played the winning shot when he potted three balls around the 10 hole with one shot and retrieved the break back after 6 minutes. Unfortunately for the local supporters, he stumbled at 1,860 and Terry finally got in for the winning break of 5,840.

Don Cadec, a 59-year-old plumber, is regarded as the "father" of the tournament as it was a twinkle in his eye which led to the birth of the event in 1981. He has been playing the game for 35 years.

Terry assures me he is only 39 (?) and a company buyer. He has played for 23 years but it is only the 6th time he has entered the B.I.O.C. He will be back next year.
