THE FOCALITE and the FINAL

At No.234 in the British Rankings, Stuart Giles was not exactly expected to be in the final, but wins over Chris Newson, Leon Beer and then the big scalp of Paul Sainsbury earned him a place in the last 16, where he went on to beat Oxfordshire team-mates Paul Caistor, Pete Lee and Maxi McDonnell (the last two with 18,000+ breaks) to reach the final.

John Burrows, saying that he has to take part in the Opens this year to restore his rightful place in the hierarchy of the ranking list, looked good from the start, making four big breaks in his first three matches against Mick Jones, Geoff Jukes and Kevin Godfrey. Three more in wins over Lorin Clough and Gary Coupar before beating fast-rising Kevin Clark in the semi-final.

Stuart started his first big final with a 7,630 break in 8½ minutes before allowing the cue-ball to go round the back of the 50 hole on a one-up shot. John stormed into a narrow first leg lead with a 7,820 reply.

The hot favourite started leg two with a 10,060 and then returned with a celebratory 5,370. John improved from 16 to 11 in the current list, and also improved his provisional position from 28 to 16.

Stuart is now an incredible 42 in the provisional list, and there was also a vast jump for Maxi McDonnell, up from 116 to 65

MATCH REPORTS (figures in brackets represent British Ranking as at the start of the match for England players, and as at the start of 1997 for Jersey players)

SESSION ONE: Graham Bisson (45) lost a hard-fought 6,500 break at the start of the 1st leg, but Keith Sheard (2) lost his 1,200 reply, so the score was still 0-0 after 13 minutes. Luckily for the recently-deposed No. 1, he opened the 2nd leg with an emotionally-charged 8,070 break.

Tony Walsh (5) seemed set for another victory when a 5,560 break won the 1st leg, but International debutant Mick Eouzan (252-) started the 2nd with a superb 12,060 effort, making the pockets look the size of his very own baseball cap.

SESSION TWO: Bernie McCluskey (20) was over 9,000 down, but started leg 2 with an 8,710 break to leave the match in the balance. Re-appointed captain Steve Ahier (49) made 1,360 in reply and Bernie started what he thought was a pointless charge for success. After putting all the balls away in conventional shots, he was left pondering whether, with a little bit of thought, he may have had a chance of scoring another 340 points somewhere.

BIOÇ Champion Terry Oakley (21) doggedly out-scored Mr Reliable Harry Barbet (60), who had been hoping to maintain his tremendous International record.

SESSION THREE: Graham Le Monnier (147-) made a 3,630 opener, swiftly offset by a 5,690 reply from Paul Sainsbury (3), and the result never seemed in doubt.

Les Green (7) won the 1st leg with a 3,700 opener, but Dennis Helleur (54) made it tough with solid play throughout, leaving Green just a little too much to do in the dying minute or so.

SESSION FOUR: Peter Farrelly (8) renewed his long series of matches with stalwart Peter Noel (128) with a handy first leg lead of 3,570, and then opened the second leg with 5,760, henceforth resting on his laurels, as Noel rallied in vain.

Jim Millward (9) always had the best of his match with Alan Le Blond (265-) and put England 5-4 ahead as captain Kevin Tunstall (1) struggled against the power

of Nigel Ryall (50-) who made an initial break of 12,160 and then another 11,230 when Kevin slipped up early in the 2nd leg.

SESSION FIVE: Steve Mariner (6) started with 5,030, but Nigel Bisson (-), 4,000 down, made it tough for Steve who eventually made a winning 3,500 break.

Luckily for England, Simon Tinto (10) did not need to beat Vernon Festou (38) in the 11th leg. Festou started with 14,740 and held on in the 2nd.

ROUND-UP: Jersey players had first break in games 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11 after Kevin won the toss. Jersey decided against going ahead with their proposal of playing for a "point per leg", and were very glad they didn't as they only won 8 legs of the 22. England were ahead in 8 matches after all the first legs.

STORY OF THE SEMI-FINALS

Saville, put in for first break, scored 2,000 but Lingham lost 5,000+ and Green scored nothing on his first visit. Brewster made just 170, Saville 30 and Lingham 170 before Green won it with a 10,900 break.

Brewster only started with 2,070 also, then after Green scored 70, Lingham 5,030 and

Saville 170, he returned for another 12,240. Green missed the 100 but Lingham potted it.

It was 1-1, but Lingham & Brewster led by 6,510. Green made a magnificent 21,530 break in leg three but not without a bit of fortune at the end. He later made the extra 130 to take his side 2-1 up, and with a lead of 15,150.

When Lingham left the first one-up short in the 4th leg, Saville came into the match with 8,750 before the game degenerated into a bit of a mess.

Tunstall, put in, also made only 2,000 at the start. Sawyer's 30 was followed by Martin's 4,700 and Trinder's 890. The Oxford boys each made 160 on their next visit, sandwiching 760 by Sawyer. Trinder made a nominal 1,140, then Tunstall finished off with 3,770.

Trinder turned the match on its head with a steady 13,900 break in the 2nd, allowing Martin only 310 at the death, and the underdogs were 5,620 ahead.

Martin's 2,520 and Tunstall's 4,130 (with Trinder not scoring and Sawyer making only 40) set the seeds for another 8,260 for Martin to give them a 2-1 and 9,290 lead.

Interesting point is that Trinder went for the 200 and blacked. Tunstall potted the 100 without anyone realising that the All-England rule states the leg was over once Trinder had felled the black pin.

Sawyer seemed to be coasting with a 9,870 start to leg 4, but Tunstall, with the game at his mercy, only scored 190 and Trinder again stepped in. A 5,750 break was enough to make the holders concede.
