"NEW DAD" KEVIN TAKES THE NORTHANTS OPEN

Kevin Clark, refreshed from a few weeks off the busy bar billiards circuit due to the birth of his first child, has won the 4th Northants Open at the Diamond Centre in Irthlingborough.

Clark, from Rochester in Kent, moved up to No.4 in the latest rankings and is now provisionally No.2 for next year, following a win over Bexhill's Paul Sainsbury in a tense final to take the first prize.

Clark held a first leg lead of 9,800 and just held on to the trophy despite a 2nd leg 10,530 - 3,810 win for Sainsbury, the current No.3 who still turns out for Berkshire despite his recent move to the south coast.

After an easy start to the campaign, Clark had to fight hard against England Ladies captain Pauline Withey (Oxford) who registered a big break of 8,550, but then saw off Alan Huntley (Oxford) and Max Dick (Eynsham) comfortably.

Clark made breaks of 16,100 and 19,260 in the quarter-final win over Dick, but won a scrappy semi-final against Wokingham's Geoff Pitt, who had won the most amazing match of the day an hour earlier.

Pitt, chasing 19,560 from Northants's Steve Biggs, actually levelled the game with one ball left in his hand, and calmly slotted it home for a winning 100 points.

Sainsbury had beaten Don Cook (Wycombe), Gary Johnson (Oxford), Mark James (Worthing), new Northants Individual champion Jason Neal, up-and-coming Mark Sawyer (Wokingham), and Keith Sheard *en route* to the final, but Sheard managed to take heart from his semi-final place as it guaranteed him a return to the No.1 position in the latest rankings.

The highest break prize, sponsored by Newton Road Garage (Rushden), was won by Brighton's Gareth Lloyd who made a 20,240 in his first round win over Sue Leach (Oxford).

Withey was given the award for best lady player, leaving the door open for Penny Burch (Kettering) to take the prize for best ladies break, both cheques being donated by Abington Glass (Northampton).

Gary Johnson (Oxford) went on to win the Barry Miller Hairstylist Plate Competition, for first round losers, opening up the final against Eynsham's Ian Moquet with an 11,840 break.

Moquet made the best break in the minor event, 16,880.

SHEARD SLUGS IT OUT FOR THE SUSSEX TITLE

Keith Sheard, Oxford and England's No.1 player, was never renowned as a player who could win low-scoring matches on awkward tables too often.

Yes, he could always race away for breaks well in excess of 20,000 and stun opponents into submission on a regular basis, but in recent years, he has matured into a player for all occasions.

Point proved at the 4th Sussex Open, sponsored jointly by Pepsi Cola and the West Sussex Builders and played at the Inland Revenue Social Club in Worthing.

Sheard struggled to find the devastating form usually associated with him, mainly due to the tables being widely regarded as "more awkward than usual", but nevertheless, he picked up the £300 first prize and consolidated his position at the top of the rankings, while the former incumbent of that position, Oxfordshire captain and team-mate Kevin Tunstall, tries desperately to regain his form and close the gap at the top of the list after a minor operation earlier this year.

Former Sussex player Mark Brewster, now living in Rochester, provided the opposition in the final, but he fell foul to Sheard's best play of the day.

Once Brewster had built up a 4,000 lead in the first leg, he really did not get another chance, and yet the event has picked Brewster up into the top 20.

The Oxford milkman posted a break of 5,000 to finish off the first leg and started the second with a 10,000 to assure himself of the title.

Sheard's only other scores of note were in the semi-final, where he made 12,990 and 14,100 against Tournament Organiser Steve Mariner (Brighton). In the rest of the matches Sheard simply did enough to qualify.

He narrowly beat Ladies No.3 Jan Taylor (Maidstone) in the first round, and one of the top Sussex girls Kim Beeching in the second. Only a very late 3,000 break gave him a close 8,510 - 7,040 decision over Ray Hussey (High Wycombe) in the last 16, and scored just 11,710 over 2 legs in the quarter-final clash with England team-mate Peter Farrelly (Northants).

Mark Brewster had a trickier schedule, beating Sean Taylor (who went on to beat fellow Sussex player Alan Messer in the Plate Final for first round losers) and two other local players before seeing off Tunstall in the last 16.

Brewster chased a 15,360 first leg break by Tunstall, and made 18,300 in two visits with Tunstall failing to step up the pace in between.

Brewster sailed on by beating Mark Sawyer (Wokingham) and Ian Street (Eastbourne) in the next two before failing in his 2nd Sussex Open final in four years.

Sawyer, the current No.13, captured the Highest Break prize for his 15,720 third round effort against yet another local player Brian Richards, with Tunstall and Street taking silver and bronze prizes.

Sheila O'Brien, Kim Beeching (both Sussex) and Jan Taylor (Kent) won the three prizes for Ladies Breaks, and Gail Woods (Redhill) was best-placed Lady.

There was also a Ladies Plate Competition, won by Taylor against Sussex namesake Anna Taylor, no relation.

KEVIN HAS RETURNED TO HIS BEST

Former No.1 Kevin Tunstall, the Oxfordshire and England team captain from Abingdon, is back to his devastating best, and that is definitely bad news for anyone trying to stop him from returning to the top of the rankings after an indifferent period during the first half of the year.

72 of the best players in the country had entered the Ninth Charity Singles Tournament in aid of the Macmillan Cancer Relief Fund, and staged at a new venue, the Admiral Cunningham Hotel in Bracknell.

Six England players were packed into Tunstall's section of the draw, so much so that his first three matches were against Steve Biggs (No.14 Wymington, near Rushden, Northants), Keith Sheard (the current No.1 from Oxford) and Peter Farrelly (No.7 from Rushden).

Once Biggs had had an early chance or two, it was Tunstall who made the big breaks of 17,410 and 14,300. The second round clash with Sheard was the most exciting of Tunstall's early rounds, and he also came the closest to defeat.

Tunstall had calmly recorded a phenomenal break of 22,000 but had almost resigned himself to defeat by the time Sheard closed in on that target with over a minute left on the clock. However, Sheard felt the pressure and blew it when only 400 agonising points short. Just that one failure to score allowed Tunstall back for 650.

So Sheard went out of the competition, somewhat unluckily as he had scored another 21,920 in the first round to eliminate High Wycombe's John Burrows, winner of the first two big events this year.

Also in this small section were Farrelly and Brighton's Jim Millward (No.9), who met in the second round after initial byes.

Farrelly's 10,770 and 12,740 saw him through to play Tunstall, but a 19,440 break proved too hot for your correspondent.

Two more big breaks gave Tunstall a 4th round win over Witney's Jon Bamsey, followed by victory over Cambridge's Phil Buckle to take him into the last four against old adversary Tony Walsh, the No.4 from Reading.

After losing the toss, Tunstall lost his opening 2,000 by knocking down the black pin, but Walsh failed to make him pay and Tunstall returned for an 18,000 break. Walsh failed at only 400 in the 2nd leg and it was all over.

Mark Sawyer from Wokingham, undoubtedly one of the young pretenders to Tunstall's crown, provided the opposition in the final. Sawyer (No.11, but provisionally No.6) had beaten team-mate Alan Chaloner in the semi-final and opened with a solid 9,500, but Tunstall set his seal on the first prize of a weekend for two to Jersey by replying with 9,090 and then starting the second leg with 12,030.

It is Tunstall's 4th Charity Singles title, an achievement highlighted by the fact that no other player has even reached the final twice in the history of the competition.

Players reaching the quarter-finals could not receive highest break awards, and so these went to Sheard (21,920) Mark Turner (Wokingham, 19,170) and Jon Bamsey (13,730).

The Plate Competition for early losers was won by Didcot's Dennis Atkins who beat Kent's John "J. J." Addley in the final.

TAYLOR AND GREEN GIVE KENT THE DOUBLE

Les Green from Rochester and Maidstone's Jan Taylor have given the Garden County of Kent their first-ever Men's and Ladies All-England Individual Championship double at concurrent events staged at the Post Office Club in Reading.

The achievement was matched by Hertfordshire (three times) and Sussex (once) in the early 1980's.

Mick Lingham (also from Rochester) was Kent's last Men's Champion in 1987, coincidentally the year BEFORE Gay Austin took the Ladies title to the county for the first time.

Whereas Taylor, now pressing hard to regain her richly-deserved No.1 status, has won this prestigious title FOUR times in the last seven years, it was Green's first attempt at the Men's Championship and becomes the 23rd All-England Champion.

Only Individual Champions from each of the affiliated counties are invited to take part, and, although Green is No.6 in the country, this year was the first time he had qualified from Kent.

Unusually, only three of the players on show were in the top 20 rankings at the start of the day, and Green would have been happy with the draw for groups. Although he was pitted against Redhill's reigning British Isles Open Champion Terry Oakley, who started the day at No.23, his other combatants were likely to pose few problems.

Sean Taylor, the Sussex champion, had been higher than his unflattering No.93 position, but had not been on the busy circuit in recent months, and seemed a little out of touch. High Wycombe's Dino Clark, at No.96, was delighted at being able to represent the powerful Buckinghamshire leagues as their champion.

The format in this competition calls for each player to face the others in the group twice, awards two points for each leg won, and one bonus for the best aggregate over each set of two legs.

Once Green had stormed to an opening 20,750 break against Oakley, it always looked fairly easy for him to reach the final. Oakley managed 12,190 in the 2nd leg, but it left him trailing Green throughout the group stages.

Green would have needed to drop a leg somewhere to give Oakley the chance, but scores of 6,720 and 10,590 against Clark and 9,140 and 11,190 against Taylor shut the door on him very tightly.

Meanwhile, the other group seemed a little more open. Favourite according to the rankings, would have been Northants' representative Peter Farrelly from Rushden, currently No.7, but he had to face up-and-coming Mark Sawyer in the first game of the day.

Sawyer, representing Berkshire for the first (but surely not the last) time, has been in tremendous form recently, with only the redoubtable Kevin Tunstall (Abingdon) stopping him in the Charity Singles Open final two weeks previously, and obviously ready to wear his first England shirt in February.

Farrelly was set a target of 16,340 but failed at 7,310 in the 2nd leg, allowing Sawyer time for another swift 11,270.

Sawyer, from Wokingham, surged past unranked Cambridge champion Pete Doherty, but dropped one leg to Oxford's Pete Welch (No.57), before consolidating with another win over Portsmouth's Chris Newson (No.58).

Sawyer won the toss for choice of break in the final, and not surprisingly asked Green to set the pace. Green was determined to stamp his authority on proceedings and played out the whole of the first leg for 19,810, made in just 17½ minutes.

Uncharacteristically, Sawyer looked ill at ease, and was behind the required rate by the time he fatally faltered at 12,410.

Green casually made a modest break of 160, but it was a very important visit, as it helped the time erode to such an extent that Sawyer was out of the hunt.

Even so, a top-speed 5,330 left him over 2,000 short at the close.

TAYLOR'S FOURTH IN SEVEN

Jan Taylor now seems set to re-establish herself at the top of the Ladies rankings for many months to come.

Although chased all the way in her group by Berkshire Champion Myra Hawkins, Taylor needed just one leg from her last match with Hawkins to be certain of reaching the final.

Whereas Taylor had taken maximum points against Surrey's promising newcomer Josie Hogan and High Wycombe's Marzena Kennedy, she dropped one leg against Portsmouth's Joyce Mannell.

Hawkins, meanwhile, dropped legs against Mannell AND Hogan, leaving her the unenviable task of winning BOTH legs against Taylor, but was swiftly seen off when Taylor won the first 2,930 - 1,170.

Hawkins was not downhearted, and finished off with a break of 12,820, bettering her own best of the day by 1,490.

It was a quirk of the format used for the event that Hawkins won all four two-leg matches in the group, and yet was pipped in the table by one point.

Taylor was in total control of the final against Northants' Penny Burch. When England team-mate Burch left her very first shot of the match well short of its target, Taylor's confidence grew and grew.

She scored 9,350 in the first leg and started the second with a winning 5,200 break.

Burch had had to contend with England skipper Pauline Withey (Oxford) in her group, but she was in good form throughout. Maximum hauls against Kim Beeching (Sussex) and Sue Court (Cambridge) left her in charge as Withey dropped one leg against Beeching.

So, again, Burch needed just one leg against Withey, duly clinched with a 5,500 opening break.

JOSIE AND SALLY: WHAT A PAIR!

Redhill's Josie Hogan and Sally Mortimer teamed up for the 5th Ladies Open Pairs Championship at their local Frenches Club, and astounded everyone, not least themselves, by winning the trophy sponsored by Woods, Sanders & Co. and the £150 first prize.

Hogan had leapt FORTY places to No.27 in the Ladies Rankings just seven days earlier after a splendid day at the All-England Championships. This title takes her up to No.18, and Mortimer up six places to No.13.

But the broad grin offered by Mortimer to her partner as she realised she had just potted the winning ball in the 3rd leg of the best-of-four final was the picture many observers will keep in their minds for some time.

The final against England regulars Jan Taylor, now back at No.1, and Alison Norman was exciting to the extreme, with the underdogs holding their nerves much better than the Maidstone-Redhill combination.

After Norman began the first leg with only 450, Mortimer found her break-building form with a 5,160, quickly followed by a 5,440 by Taylor. Hogan and Norman made short visits but a cool Mortimer 1,300 break clinched it by a narrow 390.

Hogan's opening 3,670 and her partner's 1,510 should have made it 2-0 but Taylor seemed determined to level matters, scoring a 4,130 break, only foiled by playing a basic shot too hard and seeing the ball pop out of the 50 hole. Suddenly there were six balls on the table, making it very difficult to score big-time, and eventually it was Hogan who made a modest 330 with the last few balls to win 6,030-4,400.

The aggregate difference was still only 2,020, so surely all Taylor and Norman had to do was win the remaining two legs!

Taylor seemed to be on the way in the 3rd, but, much to her obvious annoyance, pinned her opening break of over 3,000. Hogan made 2,570 in reply but Norman, on her second visit, made 2,740 to take her pair 580 ahead by the last few seconds.

Up steps Mortimer, who cannot bear to watch play when her opponents are at the table, and sinks all but one ball. When she realised her 830 with just one ball remaining left them home free and 3-0 winners, she turned and asked her delirious partner for a hug.

It was the first time they had played together, both having lost their first round matches with different partners last year, but this was to be their title.

After a first round bye, Hogan was the dominant player with a 4,650 break as they beat another Surrey pairing June Davies and Hogan's 1996 partner Katy Holloway. They had to rally from 1,700-3,460 behind at half-way to beat Kent's Lyn Harcourt and Janie Macoy, but the best performances were still to come.

They were 1,760-5,160 behind in the semi-final against holders Gail Woods and Sue Mariner, Redhill team-mates until Mariner moved to Brighton two years ago, and undoubtedly two of the best players in the country.

Mariner and Woods, however, stopped scoring and lost the 2nd leg by exactly 6,000.

Mariner had needed a late 7,390 break in the previous round when they found themselves over 6,000 down to yet another local pair, Denise Hoadley and Sheila King.

In the top half of the draw, Taylor had been prolific in her break-making. A 5,440 in the first round had been followed by 11,060 (the best of the day) in the second and 8,850 in the third. Norman had also made a 6,310 in the second round.

Taylor also made an 8,140 in the semi-final against Penny Burch (Kettering) and Janet Burns (Reading).

But they did not take the prize for the highest combined break. That was just pinched by Reading's Myra Hawkins (7,700) and Jill Josey (10,020), the 1995 winners, who lost in the first round to Christine Toner (Portsmouth) and Sue Leach (Wallingford) but went on to win the Plate Competition, beating mother and daughter Carol and Heather Banting (Sussex) 3-0 in the final.
