FANTASTIC FAZZA at FORTY-SEVEN!

Rushden's Pete Farrelly captured the Pepsi-sponsored Sussex Open in Worthing stunning himself and many, many others as he became the second oldest winner of a National Individual event since the days of Stan Pratt in the mid-70's.

Just two hours before his 47th birthday began, Farrelly picked up a £300 cheque, a prestigious trophy and a guaranteed place in the Grand Prix Masters in November. He also moves up to No.8 in the British ranking list.

It is Farrelly's third individual title at this level, having won the 1991 Wessex Open in Portsmouth and most notably the All-England Individual Championship in 1993, but has suffered a barren period since then despite reaching the latter stages of many events.

Performances varied during the day from modest victories over weaker opposition, right through tough matches with solid Sussex locals, and on to capturing the rare scalps of two of THE very best players in the country.

Understandably, as the Northants league season had finished some weeks earlier, Farrelly felt a little out-of-touch at the start of the day, but came through fairly easy early rounds against Wendy Sherratt and Alison Shilling, both local Sussex players.

By the time the last 16 stage was reached, the opposition became much more powerful, and Farrelly faced his old adversary Keith Sheard from Oxford.

Sheard has rarely lost their previous INDIVIDUAL clashes but is definitely well down on their many encounters in Pairs matches, and is a former No.1 and reigning British Open Champion, but could not match the mastery shown by Farrelly on a very awkward table.

After being asked to take first break, Farrelly made breaks of 8,000 and 4,000 to set Sheard a target of just over 12,000 in the second leg, but he could only start with 2,000. And when Farrelly matched that at a very uncharacteristically slow but workmanlike pace, Sheard's target became unattainable, and although he made another 8,000 there was never going to be enough time.

Farrelly had to show his fighting qualities when forced to come from behind in both of his next two matches. "Tarratt Tables" are only found in Sussex, and are not so

conducive to high break-building as those used in most other parts of the country, so this event highly benefits the local players who are used to their renowned "quirkiness".

Two Sussex players who were having a great tournament, Barry Holt and Paul Barnett, both eventually succumbed to Farrelly in similar fashion.

Holt started the quarter-final with a 12,150 break, forcing Farrelly to chase a 10,290 first leg deficit. And he accepted the challenge with an 11,920 reply, but this was probably the nearest he came to elimination.

Barnett won the semi-final first leg by nearly 5,000, only to see Farrelly answer with nearly 9,000 to assure himself a place in the final, but....but there waiting for him was the supposedly invincible Kevin Tunstall from Abingdon.

The former England captain has won TWENTY-FOUR major ranking events since he burst on to the scene at the age of 16, and is always a formidable opponent, especially in finals, but, after losing the toss, the ball was firmly in his court to set a target for Farrelly.

To the amazement of everyone in the hall, and to the uncontrollable joy of Farrelly, Tunstall actually played his first shot far too soft and left the table without potting a ball.

Farrelly's reply appeared modest at around 4,000, but was to prove the difference in the final outcome. Tunstall again failed to make his mark and soon found himself over 5,000 behind, before a late 3,000 break reduced the first leg deficit to just 2,160.

Farrelly had the advantage of first visit in the second leg but was shocked to see his first effort go astray too, and the door was open for the ever-dependent Tunstall to step in.

Again he failed and the second leg scores seemed to linger around the 1,000 each point for several minutes while most of the balls cowered into the most awkward places on the table.

When Tunstall was the first to return the balls to the optimum high-scoring "break" position, again the match seemed a formality, but when he lost a break of approaching 3,000 by missing an easy object ball just behind the 20 hole, Farrelly gleefully clinched the title with a celebratory 3,000 of his own.

The only player older than 47 to win a major event since the 1970's was Mick Nichol from Canterbury who won his home town Kent Classic back in 1993 at the tender age of 50, so perhaps there is life in the old dog yet!

Tunstall had had an easy route to the semi-final stage, beating Mark Senior (Sussex) with an 11,620 break, Max Dick (Eynsham) with a 14,370 break, Grant Tully, Phil Oakley and Chris Tupper (all Sussex), before feeling the squeeze against Wallingford team-mate Gary Johnson.

Tunstall's 14,720 first leg lead seemed to be useless as Johnson powered to an easy 10,000 reply, only for the latter to see a pin fall leading to an immediate handshake.

Mark Sawyer, barnstorming winner of the first Grand Prix event of the year, went down to Johnson's 11,540 break in the second round.

Current No.1 Les Green went one better before losing to Alan Chaloner in round 3.

Six players from Jersey, or more specifically "The Esplanade", made the trip over but only Nick Barnett, runner-up to Sheard in the British Isles Open, won through their first round games. Barnett won two rounds before succumbing to Surrey's Josie Hogan.

Paul Wing (Portsmouth) made a 16,050 break in his first match, but lost to Sean Taylor, who made 16,540 in two second leg breaks, by 370. Wing was not to be outdone, going on to win the Plate comfortably. He made a 17,730 break in the quarterfinal, and breaks of 14,210 and 11,650 in the semi- before facing good old Bill Trinder in the final.

The Ladies Plate went to Anna Taylor who beat Gina Sherratt in an all-Sussex final.

A new twist to the prize list, with Alan Chaloner and Sheila King winning trophies and cash for being the best "senior" players, but the question "what constitutes seniority?" will have to be addressed to the Sussex Open organisers, given that the winner of the main event was the ripe old age of 47.

Poor old Alan and Sheila! But neither are BBQ subscribers so.....

Amazingly, 30 different players have reached to the last 16 of the two Opens so far. So only two have been in BOTH.

Kevin has been runner-up in both events, and Pauline Withey has gained a Grand Prix point in both. Well done!

Kevin Tunstall has moved back to the top of the rankings by completing a full set of major events open to him.

After being beaten in the two previous Open finals this year, he has captured the Kent Classic, the only one he had never won before.

IT IS HIS TWENTY-FIFTH MAJOR TITLE, but, despite allegedly promising Les Green he would retire if he won it, Tunstall vows to carry on now that there seems likely to be a Bucks Open next year.

Tunstall was up against it many times during the day. He made it through round two despite losing a 15,000 break against Diana Welburn, but then found himself chasing a 16,110 break by Geoff Jukes. He casually recorded a 20,100 reply.

In the quarter-final, Geoff Pitt made an impressive 15,530 but had to sit it out as Tunstall made 19,900 in reply.

The semi-final was riveting stuff. Tunstall set a phenomenal target of 25,060, and, against just about anyone else, that would have been more than enough. But he was facing Mark Sawyer who had made a 29,000 in the Oxford Open earlier this year.

Sawyer was well set at 21,000 with four minutes to go, but he blew it.

The final was virtually a formality once Tunstall had set a 19,770 target against surprise finalist Roy Clough who only started the second leg with 3,240.

Surprise package of the day was local Dave Broughton who beat Keith Sheard, Dino Clark and Dennis Claydon on his way to the last eight.

Portsmouth's Paul Wing won his 2nd successive Plate Competition, beating Pauline Withey who was in brilliant form all day.

Organiser Les Green went out to Simon Degray in round two, and therefore saw his No.1 ranking disappear to the unretiring.....disretiring....."still there".....Mr Tunstall.

PERPETUAL RUNNER-UP PAUL WINS AT LAST

The Gypsy Rover has won a title at last!

Paul Sainsbury, who seemed to be the beaten finalist in everything last year, has captured the most prestigious event, the All-England Individual Championship, at Reading's Post Office Club.

It is his first All-England for Berkshire although he won the event for Kent, where he again domiciles, way back in 1986.

He is only the fourth player, after McCluskey, Tunstall and Burrows, to win the title more than once.

Paul won it by winning the toss and taking first break against 1992 Champion Keith Sheard.

Although he struggled at first and only made 2,000 on his first visit and 50 on his second, a 12,300 effort to the close of the first leg was ultimately to prove decisive.

Sheard had only made 200 at the first attempt and then lost a few points on his only other visit, looking very uneasy whenever he was given a chance.

When the Oxford milko again struggled to reach 2,800 at the start of the second leg, the title was heading back to Kent (Les Green won it two years ago) with the Berkshire champion who had ousted Mark Sawyer in their final play-off only a few days earlier.

Sainsbury, whose multi million pound company (?) also SELLS milk, failed to make a foregone conclusion when he only replied with 130. But Keith made only 170 and Paul managed to lose his minimal second chance, before Keith set about a token gesture. Time was running very short when Keith LOST a 2,500 break.

A later 6,210 by Sheard was all to no avail.

Sheard was always in charge of his group once he had beaten Kevin Clark 5-0, but Paul found it much tougher. He had to win BOTH legs against Martin Pellett to stop Terry Isard going through.

While Terry refereed his son's Under-22 semi-final, Paul JUST managed to take advantage of many chances against Martin and struggled to win the first leg by just 20, before starting the second with a re-assuring 9,000 break.

With all due respect to those nine players competing, it was not the strongest of turn-outs as the national rankings would have it. Only three of the top twenty qualified, and, in fact, the next best ranked player was Keith MacDonald who went into the day at No. 50, and went home to Cambridge at No. 32.

The best advances were made by Barry Holt and Terry Isard.
