LES SLIPS PAST IORDAN FOR "BIG BUCKS"

Now in his last full year before emigration to Greece, Les Green confirmed his status as "King of the Opens" by winning the inaugural Bucks Open final against "old codger" Ernie Jordan.

Les, now back up to No.2 in the rankings, produced a string of big breaks in EVERY round of the first big Bucks event:

First Round:

Second Round:

A 15,480 break in scores of 15,620 & 11,270 against Ian Morton

(Bucks).

Third Round:

An 11,580 break in scores of 3,290 & 11,580 against Bill Trinder (Berks) who had waited till 3.45 for his first match and then won the first leg by 2,200, only to find that he was knocked out too late to be

allowed into the Plate.

Fourth Round:

A 12,100 break in scores of 5,510 & 12,590 against Steven Sheard

(Oxon) who had also led by 2,200 after the first leg.

Otr-finals:

A 12,040 break in scores of 1,770 & 12,260 against Tony Martin (Oxon)

who had led by as much as 6,510 after the first leg.

Semi-finals:

A 20,380 break had set Ray Hussey (Bucks) far too big a task for a

second leg chase.

Final: Put in to take first break, Les started with 10,240 and then another 100 while Ernie was struggling with efforts of 50 and 10.

Les almost made certain of the title by speeding to another 9,350 break to finish

off the first leg with a lead of 19,630.

Ernie produced a sedate 5,450 in the first six minutes. Les allowed him another go very quickly but he was now chasing over 14,000 in ten minutes.

Always a stern task for Ernie who made breaks of 2,390 and 2,050 before Les

made another 7,650.

Ernie proceeded quietly into the final. When Leon Beer and Paul Wing failed to arrive, Ernie finally used his cue at 4.30, beating Dave Evans (Oxon) with a 10,400 break, Chris Newson, Terry Isard and Jon Bamsey to reach the final.

There was an unreal experience in the last 16 matches around 6.0 when Mark Sawyer lost to Tony Lewis (Sussex) by 800, Kevin Tunstall lost to Jon Bamsey, Mark Turner lost to Tony Martin and, "worst of all", Pete Farrelly lost to Ray Hussey.

At the same time, Les Green made himself hot favourite by battling back to beat

young Sheardyall on adjacent tables.

Dino Clark (Wycombe) made the greatest rise up the rankings, jumping from 77 to 60 by reaching the last eight. He had opened his campaign long before a lot of players had arrived at the venue.

At 10.00 a.m. he had rallied from 4,700 down to beat Keith Sheard with an 11,380 break. Sheard recovered later to win the Plate Competition for early losers, beating Darren

Isard in a one-leg final by starting with 13,800.

In all, a very successful first Bucks Open. Much of the thanks should be offered to Roz Piercey who sat on the desk all day, except when she agreed to replace Paul Sainsbury in the draw who could not play, and then saw Mark Turner bang a best-of-the-day 20,820 break past her.

Well done on the desk anyway, Roz!

OXFORD STORM HOME but NORTHANTS TAKE DROP AGAIN and BERKS STAY IN DIV 2 as SURREY GO UP

The headline sums it all up nicely.

Oxfordshire were on course for their fourth County Championship, and their third in four years, once they had started with a 6-1 thrashing of holders Kent.

Although they lost the next game, 4-3 to Bucks, wins over Sussex (4-3) and Northants (7-0) gave them a two point cushion over runners-up Sussex.

Sussex won all their other games 5-2 to finish two points up on Bucks, and seven up on Kent, with Northants a further six points adrift.

The only thing "certain" at the start of the championship was that Northants were long odds-on to go back down to the Second Division as they have each time they have won promotion in the past.

And this year, without their two England players for various reasons, [Steve Biggs remains top class but was not selected because he does not play regularly every week; Pete Farrelly withdrew in protest], they were always under the cosh, especially so because their league season had not even started and more than one of their players had not held a cue in anger since April or May.

The local press report stated that they were "a young-looking and inexperienced team" but there was in fact only one new player to the scene, Damien Coates.

Damien is a very promising youngster and, with the right guidance and encouragement, could do well in ALL competitions, even the Opens if only he took the opportunity to enter some.

Although he lost all his games here, with an average of just 1850, your BBQ editor tips him as one to watch, IF he gives himself a chance.

Chris Lawman (two pretty good scores) and Andy Chambers (one) chipped in, but only Simon Coleman and the usually-dependable Penny Burch produced any more victories.

It was a sad day for your Editor's home County who had struggled so hard to achieve first division status last year, now all undone so quickly. Tragic!

And they will have to face Berkshire in the second division in 2001. Hot favourites to return to the top flight swiftly, they ended level on points with Surrey, but two wins out of four was hardly material of which promotion is made.

They beat Hampshire 6-1 both times, but lost BOTH games against Surrey, who fielded two Ladies in their team. Yes, they were two top ladies (Josie Hogan and Gail Woods) but who would have thought that Berkshire would have to stay down for another season.

It all boiled down to the final games. Surrey were already 4-1 up on Berks but, due to the complicated new format, Surrey were also playing Hampshire at the same time.

Simon Tinto completed a 4-3 win in the latter, leaving Berks needing both final legs from the Surrey clash to pip them. Tony Walsh completed his 100% day with a 14,960 win over Josie Hogan, but Gail Woods did enough to beat Paul Sainsbury 11,060 - 560.

It was a good day for the girls, with FIVE taking part in the County Championships, surely a record. Sue Mariner was amongst three players unbeaten in the first division, the others being Dennis Atkins and Barry Holt, the latter being the biggest surprise package of the day.

Oxford also wrapped up the best break, via Keith Sheard, for a change, 20,230 against Penny Burch, and four of the top five in the first division averages, a little different to the struggling Northants team. They had six of their players in the bottom 11.

The "Mercurial" McCLUSKEY BECOMES FIRST WORLD CHAMPION 15 YEARS ON...

Bernie McCluskey, who gets more and more like Freddie Mercury every day, became the Queen (sorry, King) of the World when he beat BOB KING on the stage of the Hotel De Normandie, all of 15 years after becoming the first English winner of the British Open.

Bernie won the All-England Individuals FOUR times between 1978 and 1990......what other Sports could boast a World Champion who has been at the top of the game for some 22 years?

The final was played on the stage of the hotel ballroom for the first time, a space usually reserved for the presentations and the now defunct "Spoon" Challenge.

But this was serious.... Bernie asked Bob to break in the archetypal British Open final between an Englishman and a Jerseyman, but with added interest as this was billed as the first ever World Championship.

Many local onlookers actually thought this would be one of the great finals, but those who knew Bernie expected him to win fairly easily......

Bob started off with only 1,270 to which Bernie had no initial reply. Bob made another 130 before Bernie started slowly with just 670.

Bob settled into the game with a good 3,290 break but this only sparked Bernie into gear. He made a fine 5,190 to the bar, allowing Bob to add 180 to his tally in two brief visits.

So 990 was Bernie's lead, and he had his break to come in the second leg. Some thought that he may even clinch it in one go, but not quite. A 3,260 break put enough pressure on Bob to make him miss, and Bernie added another 3,210 to clinch the biggest prize in the game.

Bernie has had many great performances in Jersey over the years, but his recent form would not have given his supporters a lot of heart, but he produced a string of fine scores throughout the event.

A 6,350 break in his first match against Jenny Noel set the tone, and that continued into the second day. His first hurdle was Harry Barbet but Bernie won by 4,000. Another 6,950 break saw him into the "sheet final" where he scored 9,010 and 5,540 against Mick Fairs.

He was dead and buried in the last 16 clash with 1998 winner Keith Sheard, 3,370 - 230 down from the first leg, but 10,460 in the second took him into the last eight.

A surprise package, Richard Deadman, waited for him but did not give him any palpitations, but then Nigel Ryall was next. Bernie made 11,210 in the first leg after being put in first and that proved sufficient for the Tables Manager.

Bob King had earned his place in his first big final, beating Myra Hawkins and two top Guernsey players early on, then Barry Holt who had another fine tournament and will now be hoping for a place in February's International.

Bob then had a narrow win over regular prizewinner Peter O'Brien to give him a

shot at KT. As England supporters rubbed their hands at the prospect of an ultimate clash between the game's all-time best two players, something went wrong!

Kevin only managed 690 despite having first break, and Bob responded with a

10,850 break. Kevin simply could not repair the damage in the second leg.

The other quarter-finals produced "International" clashes of sorts. Scotland's Lorin Clough, who had beaten Keith Lewendon earlier, went down to Ryall, and now is rumoured to be planning to wear traditional costume at the Grand Prix Finals. In his last Jersey trip before he emigrates to Greece, Les Green started off his match with a 13,310 break only to have to stand by and watch KT make a 16,560 reply.

Kevin's succession of scores seemed to be pointing him towards a third Open title. Round 2: 11,260 (9,030 break), Round 3: 15,520 (7,200 and 8,320 breaks against Dennis Helleur), Round 4: 11,580 (10,430 break against Dino Clark), Round 5: 9,450 and 10,380 against Norman Wilkinson, and Round 6: 6,410 and 11,200 against Graeme Le Monnier.

In the same section of the draw, Graham Bisson beat Steve Mariner in the opening match but then lost out to Dino Clark. Also holder Peter Noel (70) won a veterans' clash with Charlie Gildersleve (73) but then lost to Alan Ferrand.

1999 runner-up Terry Race also fell early, going down to Mark Brewster in another section dominated by "veterans". Ernie Jordan beat Don Cadec in the sheet final.

One of the biggest shocks was Paul Sainsbury's defeat at the hands of Dave Stemp, not to mention Pete Farrelly losing to Janie Macoy.

I SAID NOT TO MENTION PETE FARRELLY LOSING TO JANIE MACOY!!!

One of the best matches ever seen in the early rounds was Les Green's great comeback to beat Steve Biggs in round 3. Biggs had started with 6,530 but Green was up for it and replied with 7,660.

It gave Steve a place in the TOP GUN event for the highest scoring losers in each round, but he hardly got a shot as Mark Brewster fired in breaks of 5,250 and 9,070.

Brewster also beat Vince Watts and then Barry Holt in a two-leg final.

During the weekend, an executive meeting decided that there could be either an earlier introduction to two-leg games next year OR a Plate for early losers, OR both.

Steven Sheard won the Junior event again. Surely this will not become interesting until he is allowed into the main event and the young lions can fight it out without him.

Come on Jersey, let him in........WHO WOULD KNOW?
