Despite having to find a "SAFE WAY" for a weekly excursion from Tunbridge Wells to Reading (just to play with Bernie!), Paul SAINSBURY showed just how he could "KWIKly SAVE" the £100 "NETTo" prize money in a "TESCO" Isa by finding a "LIDL" chink in Kevin Tunstall's "ALLDAYS" armour.

Enough already!!!! [Deep apologies from the editor, never again]

Paul prevented KT from completing a clean sweep of events available to him.

KT had promised to retire if he ever won the Kent Classic, the only Open he had not won. When he won it, he shamelessly reneged on the promise using the excuse that there was to be a new Bucks Open. Now, two years into the Bucks, we are still waiting to hear if he will retire if (or probably WHEN) he ever wins the event staged at the Irish Association Club in High Wycombe.

(Nice venue, nice food, pity about the Karaoke).

Just to add to the family celebration, Pete Sainsbury (for the information of Alan Donovan: THAT'S PAUL'S BROTHER, an "In" joke, and you'll need to ask one of the three involved to get the full story) managed his best ever National event performance by reaching the last 16.

But Paul's form throughout the day was "A1" (where there are many more supermarkets.....sorry, again).

A 16,290 opening break against Don Cook, followed by another 14,300 score in the second leg, and then two five-figure breaks against Ray Hussey gave him a crack against in-form Paul Wing.

"Wingy-Wingy", as he is known on the Teletubbies, had already made two 18,000 breaks in beating Pete Farrelly and Julien Bowles, but he made no progress against Paul's 16,310 first leg break.

Dennis Claydon was next for the chop. Paul only had a 3,000 first leg lead but breaks of 10,160 and 8,270 scorched him into the semi-finals.

He was positively burning when he started the semi. A 20,770 was just too hot for Dennis Atkins, another one performing at the top of his range.

Two 17,000's, a 10,000 and a 14,000 score earlier gave Dennis the basic confidence, but he never seemed to be playing quickly enough as he looked to simply play out the table and see what he could get.

18,340 was still well over 2,000 short.

The final was a war of minds.

Kevin won the toss and, as expected, asked Paul to go first. It was NOT an easy table, but Paul settled into a fine rhythm, building up speed to 9,000 in 8½ mins. He lost position for a time and the next 1,000 took nearly 1½ mins. He built it up again to 15,000 in 14 mins 20 secs and had made 17,910 at the 16 mins 45 secs bar.

Another 500 was made by clearing up the balls.

Kevin was almost visibly shaken and admitted to the scorer (Moi) as he pulled the bar to start the 2nd leg that "That's a big break on this table".

You rarely see a sign of weakness in the KT armour, but this was it. He left the red ball short on the break at 1,150, and Paul confirmed the title by making another 5,100 in quick style. Kevin conceded after only 6 minutes of the 2nd leg.

The crowd were kept entertained for a few more minutes as Tony Walsh completed

a solid win over Ray Sturgess in the Plate final.

Ray had beaten Pauline Withey in the semi, and Tony Walsh had smashed the hopes of Donovan in his semi. The latter had rallied from over 13,000 down against Farrelly in the quarter-final with breaks of 6,000 and 9,000.....[sorry Paul, I tried].

Kevin had started the day slowly by his own "fairly good" standard, with a 9,000 break and two 10,000's in the first two rounds. But a 19,800 break against the vastly under-rated Dave France was the catalyst.

Keith Sheard seems to have joined the large list of people who are overawed by KT and he cocked up his first chance in the quarter-final. Given further chances in the 2nd, he just could not settle in, and it was NOT a close game.

Mark Turner is definitely NOT overawed by Kevin, having beaten his team captain several times in big events. In the semi-, Kevin's 11,490 break and 4,000 follow-up did NOT overawe the recently-married Mark.

Mark was well on target at 8,500 when a loose shot knocked down the pin to hand it all to the No.1.

Wycombe's Steve Ellis captured the first ranking points of his career by reaching the last eight, including a first round win over Tony Walsh and a third round victory over Jon Bamsey, (maker of a 21,950 break earlier) before losing out to Dennis Atkins.

John Burrows continues to make progress back into the ranking list. He made a 17,870 break in his first match against Pauline Withey, and was only 2,000 down after the first leg against Tunstall before a controversial scoring error stopped the rhythm flowing in the 2nd leg. But keep on coming John!

Highest break of the day was Sheard's (Keith that is) 22,910 against poor Tony Lewis who had trailed 19,000 - 300 after the first leg. Close game, then!

New All-England Champion Mark James made it through three rounds, including a 15,540 break against Rosie Higham, before losing to Sheard (Keith that is).

The other Sheard (Steven that is) failed to improve on his amazing No.60 in the rankings when he lost the first round match with Eynsham's Dave Evans.

Best Ladies break was by Diana Welburn, who seems to support EVERYTHING these days. She made a 7,040 break in a total demolition of Cliff Slade. But Sue Leach (4,150) and Pauline Withey (3,250) were also impressive.

UNBEATEN MICHELLE LEADS SUSSEX TO THE TITLE, KENT GO DOWN & BERKSHIRE EASE TO PROMOTION

Sussex had struggled last year with only three wins, but they were simply unbeatable this year, especially the quiet and demure Michelle Baden, the only unbeaten player in a tough and competitive first division.

Gina Sherratt and Kim Beeching (with the best break of the day, 6,250) soon made it 4-0 before Pauline gained some revenge if not consolation with a 5th leg win over Bella.

Kent A needed to win their last two legs against Oxford A OR hope Jan Bithell beat Surrey's ex-England player Denise Wills to avoid relegation.

Jackie Peckham did her best by beating Pauline but Marina Morrison was well beaten by Jenny Parsons as all eyes stretched over to see how Denise was doing. Jan, unbeaten to that point, just lost by 540 to send Kent down by one leg, although they had more match wins and a better aggregate.

Jan Bithell, however, made the biggest leap up the rankings, from 56 to 29.

Berkshire were weakened by the late withdrawal of Myra Hawkins through illness. WE ALL WISH YOU WELL MYRA, surely even those who may be the cause of all your problems.

But Myra's team battled through well in her absence. A 4-1 over Kent B and a 5-0 over Oxford B had probably sealed their promotion within two hours of start of play.

Hants were their nearest rivals, but a 3-2 victory over them soon saw them out of the reckoning, with Jackie Watson having her best championship by winning the decider against Doreen Yorke.

Jackie topped the divisional averages, with Jane Carless (2nd) and Jill Josey (5th) all unbeaten on the day. A return to the top flight was clinched when they went on to beat Bucks 4-1 aswell, allowing them to sit out the last game with utmost confidence.

Bucks maintained runners-up spot when captain Rosie Higham won the decider in their clash with Oxford B and Hants could only beat Kent B by the same 3-2 scoreline.

Lesser mortals Clare Shaw (Bucks) and Marion Sewell (Hants) were the only others who won all their games.
