Entry of over 400 for Saturday's British bar billiards Open Three Jersey semi-finalists as Steve Ahier makes British bar billiards history

when 1992 champion Graham Biscoe of 1st Manxpoolside meets England international Peter Farrelly of Northants.

Saturday night sees the completion of the second round and with it the reduction of the field to a mere 128 players.

Sunday morning sees the start of the third round, and by the Sunday evening dinner break they will have been reduced to the last eight. The quarter-finals are scheduled for 7 pm, with the semi-finals following at 7.55.

If everything goes according to plan — and over the years things have never got more than a few minutes behind schedule — the two finalists will start play at 9.45 pm, and around 45 minutes later a new open championship will be crowned.

What next's runner-up, Terry Race of High-ton, who will be followed 25 minutes later on to table 3 (of 12) by the 1990 champion, Jersey's Steve Ahier, of the Esplanade Hotel.

Half of the draw also includes former Island champion Rod Langlois and tables manager Nigel Ryall, who faces Pembroke's Brian Cook in what promises to be one of the best first-round games.

Current Island champion Dennis Helleur, of Carrefour Selous, enters the fray at 2.40, and the afternoon session also sees the appearance of England's international skipper, Bernice McManis of Newbury, the 1985 Open winner.

The second round starts at 7.30 pm and includes one of the top matches of the day

THE British Isles bar billiards Open moves into its second decade with the 11th tournament on Saturday and Sunday at the Inn on the Park.

Once again a huge entry has ensured that the event retains its No 1 spot on the national calendar, with no fewer than 417 players hitting the title trail.

Dan Air Services have joined the Travel Leisure Group as the main sponsors, and the winner, as well as collecting the L'Etaco Woodcrafts Trophy, will pick up a holiday for two in Gibraltar and Spain.

A total of 36 prizes are on offer and every body reaching the last 16 will be assured of a reward for their efforts.

Play starts at 10 o'clock on Saturday morning and included in the first series of matches

BAR BILLIARDS history was made at the Inn on the Park over the weekend when Steve Ahier, of the Esplanade Hotel, became the first person ever to win the British Isles Open twice, successfully defending the title he won in 1990.

In the final he defeated Simon Tinto, of the Flying Scud, Redhill, to earn himself a two-centre European Holiday, courtesy of the joint main sponsors, Dan Air and the Travel Leisure Group, and retain the L'Etaco Woodcrafts Trophy.

The closing stages were played out before a crowd of around 400, with the All England Association providing five of the last eight players left in the competition, their best-ever showing. That success was to be short-lived, however, as Dennis Helleur, of the Carrefour, and Tim Douglas, of the Bagot, went through to join Tinto and Ahier in the last four.

In their quarter-finals, Steve Ahier had accounted for Redhill's Terry Oakley, while Simon Tinto was beating yet another Redhill player, Sue Barning, who in reaching the last eight was helping to guarantee a successful weekend for the Surrey players.

Dennis Helleur moved into the last four at the expense of Brighton's Steve Martner, with Tim Douglas overcoming English international Peter Feeley of Northants to book his semi-final place against Ahier.

Majestic form

The defending champion was by this time in majestic form, although his passage through the earlier rounds had survived one or two tests, not least in the very first round when he squeezed through against Mark Edwards of Eastbourne. He seemed to be saving the best for last, though, and a 15,650 to 4,490 victory over Douglas took him to his second successive final.

The Tinto-Helleur semi was a little closer, but the Redhill player always held the upper hand and went through to his first final with an 11,730 to 6,230 victory. As a regular visitor to the island, Tinto is well acquainted with local conditions, and a blend of the different styles was at this stage serving him very well indeed.

The final itself was, in hindsight, decided very early on, when Tinto, attempting to take the game to the defending champion, lost an opening effort of around 3,500. The response from Steve Ahier was immediate and decisive, and he quickly took charge to open up a comfortable first leg lead of 7,500 to 1,310.

Any doubts as to the destination of the title were swiftly removed as Ahier, performing like a true champion, rattled in a massive 13,230 second leg total to claim a decisive victory by 20,730 to 2,620 and secure a place in the record books.

Over 400 players had started out on the championship trail on Saturday morning and the usual mixture of triumph and despair ensued as the field was reduced through the early rounds.

A notable first-round casualty was the 1988 champion, Alan Le Blond, who was soon joined on the sidelines by Graham Biscoe, the Open winner in 1982, who departed from the scene in round

two at the hands of eventual quarter-finalist Peter Farrelly of Northants.

Going well at this stage was the 1989 and 1990 Jersey champion, Vernon Festou, who joined an elite band by playing the table out in his third-round victory over Harry Barbet, amassing a magnificent 14,640 total.

Festou was eventually to meet his match in a classic encounter with Dennis Helleur, who took over from him as the local individual champion last season. A tremendous fifth-round battle concluded when Helleur ended with a 200-pocket finish for a 6,400 to 6,370 victory.

As the competition moved into Sunday evening, tension was mounting as the surviving players edged ever closer to the coveted title.

Carrying all before her at this stage was Redhill's Sue Hanting, an English Ladies international, who was to become only the second lady to reach the last eight. There she met fellow Redhill 'Mobster' Simon Tinto, who came from behind to claim a 13,540 victory.

The eventual champion overcame the other Redhill survivor, Terry Oakley, and the stage was set for the historic climax.

Prior to the presentations, local league president John Aiker paid tribute to the army of local helpers who had strived to organise the tournament, in particular Nigel Ryall, who had been responsible for setting up the 12 immaculate match tables. He also thanked the 300 or so England players for their support, and expressed the hope that they would all be back in 1992.
