Editorial:

I must also thank Wellingborough's Tresham College for providing that little bit of knowledge required to use it, although many of the required tasks are still a little hazy. Scanning and e-mailing are next on the learning agenda, perhaps.

I have found it easier if I only go down to one decimal place in the ranking list, so any 0.05 will be rounded up in future. The BBQ will continue to be the Bible of the Bar Billiards World for as long as possible, and I thank you for subscribing. Without more subscribers though, it is in danger so, if you know anyone who may like to join the family, please ask them to get in touch. For some reason, SEVEN people have not renewed and I would like these replaced as soon as possible.

I mentioned in my last editorial that I had been made redundant and had produced No.49 as a full-time occupation over three weeks. This one has taken even longer as there are TWO sections in this issue which have "amused" me somewhat whilst seeking things to do to fill my time. The first recalls the most momentous landmarks in BBQ history, followed by a complete list of trophy winners since Dec 1990. Later in this record-breaking issue, you will find a fairly full list of champions recorded PRIOR to the BBQ starting so that the more elderly amongst us can try to match the old names with the even older faces in the memory bank. There are a few gaps, and if anyone can help to fill them, you know how you can contact me.

This is followed by an in-depth look at how players have moved up and down in the rankings at each issue of the BBQ. How many players do you think have appeared in the Top 20 since Jan 1991? SIXTY NINE!

B.B.Q. CELEBRATION FACT FILE

As a special celebration of this momentous 50th edition of this unique publication, I am including FOUR special items for your delectation. The first is a diary of incidents that I feel stand out in BBQ history, but I may have missed out on your personal favourite. If so, let me know what it is. The second feature (on the next TEN pages) is a complete fact file of winners since December 1990, the date the BBQ was born. Apart from keeping myself sane in these dark weeks of jobseeker's allowance, I have found some of the information quite fascinating, and I am hope you will too. At least, it will be nice to keep for reference as I do not propose to produce it again in the near future. I have had to cram it into a minimum number of pages for printing purposes, but hope you can don your specs and enjoy. If you want to check any of the facts, I have a full list of events which can be inspected at any National event over the next few months. The lists are underlined every five players to help following the names across (but you may still need a ruler), and are in the order of the expected criteria: (a) most major event wins, (b) most major event runners-up, (c) most major semi-final appearances, and then (d) alphabetical order of first initial, simply to help YOU find yourself, not in the psychological sense of course. The column headings are for Individual events (I), Pairs events (P) and Team events (T). Plate Competitions include the Jersey "Top Gun" events for highest scorers in the early rounds which took place for two years prior to the Plate Competition being introduced. It is (or SHOULD be) a complete list of success from the International Match in 1991 up to the British Open Pairs in 2003, i.e. up to the close of BBQ No. 49. Later in this issue, you will find that I thought I should give a fairly full list of winners PRIOR to the BBQ starting, followed by a "progress" report of all players who have been in the top 20 of the rankings when each BBQ was issued.

MOMENTOUS LANDMARKS IN B.B.Q. HISTORY

09.12.90	A ridiculous proposal at the AGM provided the impetus for the BBQ to be born.
Jan 1991	Ranking system formulated, and agreed by Ken Hussey for some reason.
02.02.91	First ranking event, Jersey v England, but initially only England players qualified.
Mar 1991	9-page BBQ No. 1 issued, £2 per year, but County Secretaries received it free.
Jan 1992	First 20-page BBQ, mainly due to results from Jersey.
Apr 1992	Simon Tinto now helping with the presentation. Paul Brice helping with copying. Up to £3 per year. Now over 50 subscribers for the first time.
Apr 1993	News breaks that bar billiards reports are to appear in POT BLACK MAGAZINE. Guess who is volunteered to write the reports FREE!!!
Oct 1993	Produced again solely by Farrelly, with Bricey still doing all the copying at work. BBQ's illegitimate children born in Sussex: "3BQ" "NSBQ" and "Even Break".
Jan 1994	£5 a year now. All ranking points gained in 1991 now eliminated. 22 pages.
Apr 1994	Steve Mariner donates cassette ribbons to help with printing the BBQ. 25 pages. Eric Hill gets Norman Morton to do the copying for a while, until he retires.
Jul 1994	Channel Islands players now included in the rankings. First 30-page BBQ.
Jan 1995	My dear old Mum buys me a portable word processor, making the BBQ more presentable.
Jul 1995	A 42-page whopper, with 12 pages devoted to <i>Despatches</i> .
Jan 1997	AGM raised subscription to £7.50, but still about 70 subscribers. Kevin loses the No. 1 spot for a short spell. Many recounts took place!!!!
Mar 1997	Pot Black coverage starts to falter, just after offering to pay for the information. Keith Sheard loses his place at No. 1 in favour a new face. Kevin Tunstall.
Jul 1997	Copying assistance from Neil Mackmin ends, so BBQ No. 26 is the first produced solely by me, causing the costs of producing the BBQ to spiral upwards.
Jul 1998	Pot Black declines further so detailed reports start appearing in the BBQ instead. The BBQ employs three new Afghan refugee reporters to help with the workload, S Hitsturra, Tel Itazitiz and Khan T'Mone-Iffeumissthubrake, but it doesn't last as they are all deported back to the Middle East and never heard from again.
Oct 1998	BBQ publishes an all-time list of major championship winners and a Money Winners list from the start of BBQ coverage. Well I didn't have a holiday that year!
Jan 1999	After Katie and Milko had been vying for the No. 1 spot for nearly two years, Les Green slips into top spot for six months, but by July Katie is back, never again to be headed to this day, and with his current lead, he looks safe for this decade at least. The best BBQ wind-up of our "Katie". HE receives a different page 1 than everyone else. HIS copy discloses a massive increase in ranking points for the Alternative Rules, a competition what he decides not to enter. ALL others are told a joke at HIS expense. OK, the joke was not very funny, but the fact that he did not know about it was mildly amusing for some of us.
Apr 1999	Pot Black liaison ends for good.
Jul 1999	Players in KO events are no longer listed in "draw order". The BBQ details for each event will now start with the winner which seems to be easier to follow progress throughout.
Jul 2000	Lorin Clough temporarily joins the team but the editor feels the stress. Sir Tiffy Cut begins his quarterly award scheme.
Jan 2001	Another 42-page blockbuster to celebrate the 10 th Anniversary of the BBQ.
Aug 2001	After a long period of uncertainty, the BBQ is back on track with a 40-page up-date of all the results previously missed.
Jan 2002	A 37-page BBQ 44 is accompanied by an Addendum. Nuff sedd!!!
Jun 2003	BBQ hits FIFTY, and not a cake insight.
Dec 2007	Fazza finally hands over the Editorial role to his up-and-coming great-great-grandson.

JOHN "BURROWS"-THROUGH FOR THIRD ALL-ENG TITLE

The winner of the All-England Individual Championship in 1995 and 1998, John Burrows from Thorne (which is somewhere near High Wycombe?) has won it for the third time and is now just one behind the number that both Kevin Tunstall and Bernie McCluskey have won. Other than Paul Sainsbury (twice), nobody else has won it more than once.

Even though he only won the aggregates against Chris Saville and Mark Allfrey, he only required another aggregate victory over Bernie McCluskey to qualify for the final. Under the old scheme he would have needed to win BOTH legs as Bernie would have been 8 pts to 6 ahead. As it was John won both legs anyway, but it seemed to slightly devalue the game as John won the leg against the break, leaving the 2nd leg virtually redundant.

Kevin Tunstall was always favourite for the other group, only dropping one leg to Barry Holt, who made a 137/60 break against him. But the star man was Phil Buckle who lost both legs to Kevin but only one other leg throughout.

The final was eagerly awaited, but John, put in first, missed the first split. He managed to get it back and then settled down magnificently for a superb 18,990 break, beating Kevin's highest break of the day, made against Barry Holt.

Kevin inexplicably messed it all up at only 1,400 when he came inside the 50 on the split. The break back attempt just did not happen and Kevin was stunned, unable to explain what had happened. John made an unnecessary 8,890 reply and Kevin conceded at the end of it.

According to the statistics elsewhere in this issue, John just never loses finals.

What a tremendous advantage that is.... Tremendous for the player, and a big psychological boost over the opponent.

SUSSEX TITLE No. 3 FOR OUR KATIE

Kevin Tunstall won his first National title and then everyone woke up and it was all a bad dream.

Yet another major title for Katie, but you'll have to work out how many that is now, 'cause I can't be bothered anymore.

Well actually I will. It is his TWENTY-EIGHTH major singles title, but you have to add SIX pairs titles (including one Mixed Pairs) and at the last count SEVEN team titles (most, if not all, as captain). That is 41, twenty more than the next best Bernie with 21. [Please note that if Kevin's figures do not add up according to the information given elsewhere in this BBQ, it is because I have since found that he actually won the 1990 Wessex Open].

Many players just cannot produce their best against the Great One, finding it difficult to keep him off the table, possibly as they know full well that, if they don't, they may not get another shot.

Even Tony Walsh, who has a better-than-most record against Katie, could not push him in the final, even after winning the toss. Kevin played out the first leg (bar the last ball), making 17,120 in 17 mins 25 secs. Self-critical Katie thought he was slow as the balls were "taking forever to come down the trough".

But it was easily enough for Tony who pinned his initial 2,000 and, even though Katie missed, was never in contention and conceded as soon as he missed again.

A small amount of revenge was registered the very next day when Tony beat Kevin in the 1st leg of a Reading Summer league match. Out of interest, Kevin's team still won 3-2, aided by a slight diversion on the way home from Worthing for Pete Farrelly who beat someone called Bernie McCluskey (on his own table???) Unbelievable!

Kevin had, as usual, improved during the tournament, which takes some doing when he starts superbly. A 10,840 break beat off Andy Haines, followed by a 13,930 break to beat off Tony Webster. The only time he was in trouble leading up to the final was in the third round when facing Dino Clark (still keeping his Bournemouth form going). Dino made a solid 14,620 in the first leg to make Katie think, but all he thought about was passing it. He did it comfortably with a 17,220 break.

Even Paul Sainsbury, who had beaten Dennis Atkins and Nigel Senior on the way, could not stop the immovable force that is Kevin Tunstall. Even Steve Mariner, on his own beloved Tarratt tables, could not halt the tide when, chasing Kevin's 15,300 opener, Steve messed it up at only 4,000.

Even Ian Street, new kid on the block who lost in the Oxfordshire Open final, had absolutely no reply to Katie's vast experience in a tough semi-final.

It just gets boring! Nothing against Katie, it just seems that everyone else will have to get better. It COULD lose the No. 1 spot in the rankings.....if he takes about two years sabbatical.

Geoff Pitt had (probably) the most memorable day of his long career. After beating more-than-capable Jane Wood, Tony Martin and Ernie Jordan, he then astounded everyone (including himself) to beat a rampant Keith Sheard (on the notorious and dreaded table 10) and then, in the next round, by coming from well behind to beat John Burrows in the nick of time by 490.

In fact, he should have beaten Tony Walsh in the semi-finals but simply could not get to grips with table 5. He was well clear in the 1st leg but allowed Tony in for an attacking 5,000 break which put him 1,940 ahead. Geoff messed up his very first shot in the 2nd and Tony seemed well in command, even though one of his mighty break shots had spun out of the 50 hole and ended up within 3 inches of the red ball spot. Tony continued to fire in the break shots at pace and was home and dry by the time he again spun out the 50 hole and, this time, felled the black pin just as the bar dropped. Geoff had 1,470 on the board and so needed 480 to win with the last few white balls.

The break shot was not to his liking, so experience told him to play the one-up and split shots. He succeeded once but then missed the 2nd one-up to hand it terminally to Tony.
