## SO WHATEVER HAPPENED AT THE A.G.M.?

Even though Ken Hussey did not attend and spread doom and gloom amongst us all, it was the liveliest meeting for many years.

Dave reiterated that he WILL retire in two years. Honorarium was increased to £500.

Treasurer Keith MacDonald condemned players who avoided paying the full admission fee at All-England events, and never bought raffle tickets. Keith intimated that he would also leave the committee in 2 years.

Northants have withdrawn from the County Championships due to the "travelling involved" and the fact that they dislike having to play only three matches and have to sit out for at least one series during the day.

Oxfordshire were criticised by Phil Hawkins for welcoming so many top players from other counties which he thought was to the detriment of the game. He said that these players should stay in their own county and build up the game. Pete Farrelly said he tried that for over 25 years and got stabbed in the back, and Paul Wing made an even angrier personal response.

Paul also expressed his dismay at his Taxi Company not getting due recognition for sponsoring the International Match last February.

The committee was returned *en bloc* for another year, except the Tournament Director who made it clear he would resign when the Group points system was changed for the third successive year.....and it was, so.....bye bye.

### PROPOSALS:

Proposal to bring back the old points system in group events (0.2 for each leg and 1.1 for aggregate) was suggested by N Senior, but not seconded. **No vote was taken.** But there was an amendment to change it to 2 pts awarded for the aggregate only, prop P Wing, sec K MacDonald and this was **carried 7-0**, however, no other criteria was discussed to split players/teams who finish level on points.

Proposal to reinstate the Off-the-Spot event (in addition to the present Alternative Rules with the Triangle). Maybe staged in Surrey in January because they usually have the tables in that month, open to all but especially for the England team to practice. **Agreed.**

Proposed that Counties could enter a "B team" for the County Championship, starting in Division 2. It was thought Oxon and Sussex may be the only ones likely to be able to enter and, although it would be a very long day (especially if the Ladies All-England Individuals was retained for that day), it was **agreed 8-6**. Prop K Tunstall, sec D Atkins.

The seeded players in the Grand Prix will be "shuffled up the list" if any players did not accept the invitation to play, rather than the reserves slotting into the vacated place. Prop M Turner, sec K Tunstall, **carried 12-0**.

Players will be asked to "refrain" from smoking at All-England events in Reading, Bournemouth (main playing area) and the International venue in consideration of people who did not smoke. This was an amendment to the original proposal which requested smoking to be banned. Proposed by Cambridgeshire and **carried 7-5**.

Tossing **MUST** be fair, honest and open. Taking a coin from your pocket and placing it on the table is not permissible. A call must be made while it is in the air, before it is caught in the hand and placed on the back

of the other hand, or allowed to fall to the floor. The result must be shown to both players, otherwise it will be deemed a "foul toss". Proposed by P Hawkins, sec D Barnes and **carried overwhelmingly**.

### SELECTORS:

E Hill, K Lewendon, D Barnes, K Tunstall, B McCluskey, C Saville, and N Senior, but P Withey and S Atkins were not involved this year as there was no Ladies team to select, and P Wing and P Farrelly resigned from the panel. Hampshire and Surrey were asked to find a representative to join the selectors.

## EDITORIAL

A big vote of thanks from the Editor and all subscribers for PAUL SAINSBURY, who now receives the final draft of each BBQ on e-mail, prints them out and collates all the pages. I then provide the stamped, addressed envelopes via his local Stormont Truck & Van depot and Paul gets them posted them out for me. That really saves an awful lot of time and enabled the last edition to reach most of you before flying off to Jersey. Let me assure you that my 4 copies per minute copier would not have achieved that. Time is such a valuable commodity.

### THANK YOU Mr SAINSBURY, henceforth never to be called "TESCO" again.

I consider myself privileged to be able to have my say here about the problems which currently endanger the continued existence of the All-England Bar Billiards Association, and in particular the reasons why I have felt it necessary to resign my positions on both the Committee and the England Selection Panel. I am not trying to unduly abuse this privilege, as some people will undoubtedly think, I am simply trying to bring to a head the problems looming within the next two years that nobody seems to be taking seriously.

It shows the state of this Association when the AGM spends time discussing how people should toss a coin. Can you believe it?

The main problem is that the Association simply needs new blood NOW!

There will be 2 or 3 further vacancies on the All-England Committee within the next two years but everyone seems content to sit back and wait for someone else to stand up and be counted. Why don't those who have criticised recently (either verbally, or those continually trying to propose the same unnecessary changes every year) now step forward and put their TIME and efforts where their ample mouths are. I do not personally wish to work closely with these people, but there again I don't have to, because I am not the Tournament Director any more.

I had decided the week before the AGM that it would not take too much for me to go ahead with my prepared resignation speech due to work and family commitments, as well as the ridiculously high number of new schedules I have had to prepare this year; some with very little time in hand, by far the worst being the Grand Prix Finals day when I was trying to sort out a new schedule for the day just a few minutes before trying to settle into "playing mode". Difficult anyway, but when you feel that you are playing for your England place, this is multiplied greatly.

Why should I feel my place in the England side was at stake when I have had an otherwise good year, (a) reaching the quarter-finals in both the Kent Classic and Sussex Open, (b) reaching the last 16 in the Pairs, (c) winning the Alternative Rules PLATE (with a run of scores second to none), (d) reaching the Jersey PLATE Qtr-final (despite having ridiculous abuse hurled at me by one of my "favourite individuals" immediately before one game because I was playing another Sussex player), and above all (e) winning all 4 games in a very successful County Championship team with a top 10 average of 8,000.

I have arguably had a year far superior to many of the players who were named in the side ahead of me, yet I did not have the support of the Captain or the "Chairman of Selectors", the latter having been present at only a handful of events during the year, and invariably leaving the events he did attend as soon as he had been eliminated. And then making it worse by denying his influence on the selection when, coincidentally, answering a question from the floor at the AGM about his limited number of appearances.

And this less than two years after I was successfully appointed "England Manager" when none of the other Committee members would/could make the trip to Jersey.

Admittedly, I did not start too well in the Grand Prix this year but it is no coincidence that I played much better towards the end of the day when all the admin problems had been sorted out. My group was so close that winning one more leg would have taken me through at the expense of the eventual winner, conveniently forgotten by a few of the selectors. So my only truly poor performance was in the Oxfordshire Open when I was unable to use my usual stance due to a severe backache. When this was pointed out, another selector said that he always played with a bad back anyway. But he wasn't up for selection!

And then I get edged out of the team by someone who has won only 2 out of 4 in the county championships (25<sup>th</sup> in averages) and lost in the first round of the other two events he has entered during the year (inc Jersey), and also someone who admittedly has done well in the County Championships, the All-England and Jersey this year but showed his inconsistency by winning no more than 2 matches at any of the FIVE other events he entered.

So I will not be sitting on the selection panel in future. It is not worth my time. They will have to get someone else to provide players' statistics in future, or perhaps facts don't mean anything anymore.

This was the first time in many years that ALL the selectors have actually been present for the meeting. We have so often had one or two selectors sending in his list of 11 players on a piece of paper. How can this be a way to select a team?

Despite this, I would certainly have tried to carry on as Tournament Director somehow if I thought it would be worthwhile, but sadly I don't think it is worth the hassle any more. The two main reasons for this are (a) the attitude by certain people towards the admin desk and (b) the ridiculous attempt (in my humble opinion) to change the points system for group games for the THIRD year in a row.

When the proposal was discussed, I made it clear that I could not support another change and was on the verge of walking out of the meeting immediately when the amendment was accepted without ANY thought of additional criteria to decide league placings. During the recess which followed, the penny dropped about another fault in the newly agreed system, (i.e. what is there to play for in the 2<sup>nd</sup> leg of a match if YOU are chasing a total you KNOW you cannot reach?)

There is talk of an EGM during the Bournemouth weekend. I know who I would like to be nominated to replace me, and you surely know who that is. "Put your time where your mouth is, and see how it feels when people start moaning at you when you are trying to fair to everyone".

I do wish to thank Alan Messer (the Sussex secretary) for distancing himself and his committee from the views of those people who make the job of Tournament Director a total nightmare.

You may or not agree with me, but I believe these people have a lot to answer for. Nobody will want to be on the admin desk if their authority is undermined by people turning up late for a second successive year and then trying to drum up support on the floor for them not to be disqualified.

### THE B.B.Q.

I will be endeavouring to make sure that none of the usual content of the BBQ is affected by the fact that I am not now on the All-England Committee, but this cannot be promised if event organisers, and especially the new Tournament Director, do not provide the required information.

I am hoping to attend most of the events, as always, but I cannot guarantee it so, if I am not present, someone will HAVE to provide the statistics or it cannot be included in the RANKINGS or even the BBQ's Grand Prix lists. You must not leave everything to Dave Barnes. I would expect to receive all the statistics from an event within three weeks.

I now have 95 subscribers, nearing on the 100 for the first time, so at least the BBQ family is looking strong.

So please get your subscriptions in as soon as you can. This will cover the next four issues, due out in April (after the Mermaid), July (after the Kent), October (just in time for Jersey) and around Christmastime 2005.

With all this happening, please excuse me if this issue is a little less jovial than usual. Someone did not seem to like my feature in the last issue, allegedly actually dying her hair to make herself more like Anne Robinson than anyone else.

No, stop it! We must not laugh! I will never watch *The Vicar of Dibley* again.

## THE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

AT THE DE NORMANDIE HOTEL, JERSEY, SATURDAY 13<sup>th</sup> / SUNDAY 14<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2004

### DOUBLE UP FOR TERRY RACE

Terry Race obviously likes the change of name of this tournament from the British Isles Open to the World Championships because he lost the BIOC finals in 1990 and 1999, but he has now reached the WC final for the last three years and has won two of them. He will probably admit that Jim Millward was just too strong for him in 2003, but he overpowered Nigel Ryal in 2002 and did so again this year.

**Who would want to play him next year?**

Terry won the toss and asked the tournament's Tables Manager who plays his BB at the Trinity Arms to go in first. Nigel only made 1,800 off the break and Terry stepped in to go over 4,000 ahead after ten minutes play. He messed about around the 50 hole for a while and made a break of 6,540. Nigel missed the red ball on the edge of the 10 pocket and Terry made just 100. When Nigel failed to score again, Terry made a very assured 2,940 in the remaining time to go 7,780 ahead.

It was all over when Terry started leg 2 with a break of 7,650 which left Nigel barely 7 minutes to make well over 15,000. He made 2,880 with a trace of a resigned smile on his face before Terry made further scores of 1,980 and 1,200.

Terry had defeated No.1 Kevin Tunstall in the semi-final. Katie was desperate for his 50<sup>th</sup> title to come when crowds were watching. It would have been his third Jersey victory, trying to equal Jim Millward's third success last year.

Nigel prevented another all-English final by beating Bernie McCluskey in the other semi-final. Bernie would also have been going for his third title.

Terry had been dominant in every match and only seemed in trouble in the quarter-final against surprise package Dave Reeves, who had only previously captured 1.3 ranking points but has now jumped to No.71. An amazing sequence of breaks (6,200 7,710 7,500 9,730) took him through to the last sixteen where he walloped Les "The Greek" Green by nearly 15,000 on aggregate.

Incidentally Les had instigated a swift change of definition in the prize list. He made the best single leg break of 9,270 in the first round, and the "BEST UK BREAK" prize suddenly became the "best EU break".

But Reeves, who had already beaten four possible winners; Dennis Helleur, Nick Barnett, Dennis Atkins and Paul Sainsbury, led by 1,530 before Terry made his best break of the weekend (8,660) just when he needed it most. The sign of a true champion.

The other quarter-finals all saw bigger breaks than Terry's. Katie's 10,230 break was required to see him come from 2,500 to Guernsey's Bob Chapple. Ryal made a 12,380 break to beat Terry Oakley, who was the first to win the event at the De Normandie in 1996. The best was Bernie's 13,580 effort to see off another surprise Sussex challenger, Neil Higgins.

There were some other fine performances from Dave May and Michelle Baden. Dave beat Graham Bisson, Alan Ferrand, Mike Matthews and Peter Noel, while "Osama" beat Alan Le Blond on a 200 last ball shot to get into the last 16.

Holder Millward won three games (inc Graeme Le Monnier) before losing to Paul Sainsbury who made an 11,600 break when chasing a deficit of 6,720. Mark Turner (who may just one day be able to hold himself together to win this event) won three games with breaks of 7,870 and 8,940 (the latter winning the 2<sup>nd</sup> UK break prize) to reach the last 32 where he could only make a 6,870 when chasing Bernie's 10,800.

Others like Harry Barbet, Nigel Bisson, Ray Sturgess, Mark James and Barry Holt won 2 games, and previous winners Steve Ahier and Trevor Gallienne both only reached round two, but there were first round exits for Steve Mariner, Sue Mariner, Keith Sheard, Pauline Withey, Graham Bisson, Leon Beer, Pete Farrelly, Paul Wing and Chris Saville making the Plate Competition a little heavy.

Wing was unlucky enough to face Jane Carless in good form.

Steve Mariner was desperately unlucky to have to chase Terry Oakley's score of 7,750. The Sussex star had had an early chance and seemed well out of the hunt but stormed back with a 6,430 break, falling just 1,320 short when he should not have got within 3,000.

Of course.....Farrelly was the unluckiest, "seemingly" well in control against Terry Kenny who then proceeded to make a break of 8,520, the best CI break of the event, and well above his normal expectation (apparently).

In that "heavy" Plate, Graham Bisson dominated with a string of big breaks, including 13,170 against Ronnie Wren and a brace of them against Leon Beer in the semi-final. His two identical breaks of 4,800 in the 1<sup>st</sup> leg of the final led Sheard to concede a one-sided match soon after he missed his first one-up shot.

Farrelly just missed out on a much-awaited semi-final match with Sheard when a good run ended with defeat against young Jersey starlet James Jeanne.

The BBQ prediction of the last 16 was NOT as accurate as in previous years, with only Race, Tunstall, Ryall, Jukes and Paul Newton reaching their predicted places in the last 16.

### THE JUNIORS

Nicholas Wren, a 13-year-old from Gillingham and representing the Medway League, is only the 3<sup>rd</sup> ever winner of the Junior BIOC and the only English player to reach the final apart from Steven Sheard, who won it five times 1997-2001.

He beat Guernsey's Ben Wilding by just 600 in a low scoring final, but Nick Ogier (also from Guernsey) must be counting himself unlucky after making easily the best break of the day (3,300) in beating Shane Gallery in the only preliminary round match, and then losing out by 90 in the first round proper against Matthew Kershaw.

It was only the second time Nicholas had entered the event, but seems fairly confident of a long run at the top.

**NEXT YEAR will be the 25<sup>th</sup> Jersey Championship on November 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> 2005.**

Phil and Myra Hawkins easily won their group but could not reproduce it in the semi-final, while the closest contested group was won by Witney's Paul and Jane Wood. The Gloucestershire-based pair just pipped Reading's Jane Carless and Bill Trinder on aggregate by a meagre margin 42,340 - 39,330, but were no match for Su and Katie in the semi-final.

Nor were Richard and Jean in the final! Richard seemed well in command with a 3,500 break in the 1<sup>st</sup> leg, but one slip-up allowed Katie to make a 9,420 and take control with Su's break to come.

She started with 1,700 and the table was bogged down until Katie made 3,990 on his 2<sup>nd</sup> visit to clinch it. It would have been Jean's first title since winning the 1983 All-England, but surely she could not be that old, could she?

Prizes were £20 each for the winners, £10 runners-up, £5 semi-finalists and £5 for the best ladies break, all paid for from the entry fees.

Surely, the event is now a permanent fixture on the calendar.

Mark laughed when the BBQ started calling his captain Katie, and liked it when his mate Lorin Clough was renamed LC / or "Elsie," but how he reacted when he was called MT / or "Empty" is not yet being recorded in this family publication. But he should not complain as "Empty" is exactly what he does to the fridge every night!

His size certainly has not affected his play, storming up to No.7 in the rankings after winning this, his fifth major individual title.

Quick resume of his previous successes: An 11,200 break to beat Katie for the 1995 Alternative Rules (Spot), a fine thrashing of Bernie for the 1999 Charity Singles, a 16,790 break again to beat Katie by 1,290 in the 1999 Grand Prix Final, and a 20,370 break to beat Katie yet again by just 390 in the 2004 Oxford Open Final. Do we see a pattern here?

He is obviously the man to beat Katie! He did so again in the semi-final here, before going on to beat Dave Reeves, who cannot be called a surprise finalist after recent adventures, in a low-ish scoring final which reflects the standard of tables on the day.

Mark's group was the keenest fought with only one point separating the four competitors, and only making it through by an aggregate of 1,660. But Empty lost his opening match of the day, as did Katie, the eventual winner last year. The 3-0 defeat to Ian Street should really have put him out of contention, especially when he lost the opening leg against Pete Farrelly, but he finally got his play in order to win all his three remaining legs and qualified for the last four when he successfully relied on his old mate Fazza to beat Ian 3-0 in the last of the qualifying matches.

Katie only dropped one leg, against Paul Sainsbury, in his group, shutting out Keith Sheard 3-0. But, with Paul winning nothing else all day, Bob Chapple took a lot of pride from his first trip to play bar billiards in England by finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the group with a leg off Keith and two of Paul in what could have been a very tough initiation.

Dave Reeves won all his 6 legs in group 4 and is now climbing to No.41 in the rankings after stunning John Burrows and all spectators alike with an amazingly assured display under pressure. He completely locked the Bucks star out of the game.

Chris Saville won the right to go into the other group by virtue of a draw of lots with Fazza, but failed to make progress in an open group eventually won by Tony Martin, who won all his games 2-1.

The ranking points system for the Grand Prix Finals has been modified slightly to reflect performance in the group system.
