Mr ARTHUR STACEY

Just before this BBQ went to print, I heard that Arthur Stacey had died at the age of around 81. Arthur took over as All-England Secretary from Horrie Wood (Kent) in the mid-70's and was succeeded by Ken Hussey in December 1979. Arthur had also been High Wycombe President for many years and a very good player in his day, winning the Wycombe league about 8 – 10 times with the Royal British Legion (Wycombe Marsh) with players like Norman and Alan Morton and a "youthful" Kent Murray. The funeral was at Amersham Crematorium on Wednesday October 26th at 12.30 p.m.

5. Who are the only three players to have played KT more than twice and have won more times than they have lost? (3) Kevin Clark, Andy Harcourt & Bill Trinder
6. Who are the only three players to have played KT more than twice and have won exactly 50% of their games? (3) Mark James, Jon Bamsey & Jim Millward
7. Who has lost all 7 of his encounters with KT? (1) Barry Holt
(NOW 8 times after this year's All-England final)
8. Which ex-World Champion has lost all 5 of his encounters with KT and is the highest ranked player who has never registered a win against him within this time? (1) Bernie McCluskey
9. Who is the next highest ranked player never to have beaten KT? (1) Nigel Senior
10. Who beat KT for the first time this year, after 12 successive defeats? (1) Geoff Jukes
11. Who is the ONLY lady player to have beaten KT? (1) Sue Mariner
12. Which ex-England International has only beaten KT twice in 12 attempts, both times being in the Pairs Open? (1) The calculated answer was Mark Sawyer, but I have now very graciously conceded that Mark did, in fact, also win a "memorable" (to most) Oxfordshire Open final against the great KT in 1999, which totally nullifies this question. I will have to take a penance on that!
13. Who has played KT seven times, beating him on three occasions and has gone on to win all three of those events? (1) Pete Farrelly
14. Which Jersey player has lost all his four matches against KT? (1) Nick Barnett

This report is compiled without being present at the event, due to a pre-arranged holiday, and the IAAF would simply not change the date of the Athletics World Championships, despite a plea by the BBQ editor. All information has therefore been provided by Eric Hill. Thank you.

Six finals so far this year in the Grand Prix series, and uniquely there has been TWELVE different finalists. The Bucks Open, which had been abandoned last year, duly landed in the lap of the ever-popular Dennis Atkins who beat the (seldom seen and almost forgotten) 1991 All-England Champion Kent Murray in a fairly low scoring final.

The general opinion of those who were present was that most of the tables were tricky, and the number of recorded 10,000 breaks during the day was only 12 (albeit spread out over 7 of the tables in the room), so this could be a reasonable excuse for the final not being a great spectacle of supreme bar billiards, despite the fact that the best break of the day had earlier been made on the same table.

But Dennis, runner-up to Kevin when the event was last staged in 2003, and his "barmy army" of supporters will not mind a jot.

The story of the final: Kent Murray, put into bat, lost his opening 2,500 break when the 100 popped out and he missed his cushion shot. Each player made 4 or 5 visits before Dennis finally retrieved the balls to the break position and made a break of 9,500.

Dennis only opened the 2nd leg with 2,000 but Kent's rally ended at 6,280 before the game became scrappy, which suited the player with a 5,000 lead.

His semi-final against Tony Walsh was of a higher class. After opening with a 13,570 break, Dennis may have been nervous as Tony chased him. But after the Berkshire man had made only 2,000 in each of his first two visits, the game again became scrappy and he soon ran out of time.

In the other semi-final, Terry Isard (another former All-England champion) was put in and battled out a 6,000 lead, but Kent closed the gap to about 500 with his first break of the 2nd leg. Terry failed to step in and Kent made a winning 2,440.

The quarter-finals could have seen a break-through into the big time for Chris Reeves, although Eric's report missed off the "s" making me think that "Superman" had turned to bar

billiards. Chris opened with 4,500 but then pinned his 3,000 follow-up. Dennis took full advantage with a break of 7,410 to gain a 2,570 first leg lead and then started the next with another 8,890.

But the big story of the round, if not the day, was the tie between Kent and Mark Turner. Kent only made 1,300 in his timed break, leaving the door open for the new Daddy. But Mark left a ball in the middle of the table from a ropey split shot, played off the cushion and missed the ball.

Although not present, we can guess that Mark was very, very disappointed.

Terry's quarter-final was against Chris Saville, who had earlier beaten Keith Sheard. Chris missed his first one-up shot and never recovered, with Terry making a series of small contributions throughout to win by about 7,000.

The last quarter-final was, allegedly, of the highest standard with Nigel Senior starting off with 7,400, but then becoming a spectator as Tony Walsh made breaks of 3,000 and 11,210.

The highest break of the whole day also went to Tony for a 19,800 effort against Dino Clark in the last 16, with Pauline Withey capturing the Ladies prize for her 3,430 break in her second round defeat against Ernie Jordan.

Pauline actually made the best break of anyone in the Plate, although that went unrewarded. Her 5,900 effort against Cliff Slade only saw her through to the late eight where she narrowly lost to eventual runner-up Barry Vass. "Big bully" Barry, one of three players who came in as late substitutes, had earlier beaten Kady Claydon and Andrea Blackburn, and then KO'd Jason Wadsworth before losing the final to Portsmouth's Tony Webster in the "heavyweight" final. Tony had also had to play three ladies on the way: Jean Claydon, Dawn Jordan and Michelle Baden.

But it lifted Barry 78 places in the rankings to 170. The most significant leaps in the list were from Chris Reeves (129 to 94) and Kent Murray (146 to 75). Martin May and Tony Hearne gained their first ranking points.

BBQ TIPSTERS DERBY: Chris Saville won with 4 quarterfinalists predicted correctly, only because no one else thought he would get through against Keith Sheard. Kevin Pringle and Pete Farrelly were next best with 3 correct. Farrelly was the only one to see Terry Isard as a potential quarterfinalist, but was also the only tipster who failed to back Tony Walsh. Nobody received any bonuses for getting either finalist correct, hardly shocking news!

The 7th event of this year's Grand Prix series and "Suddenly I See" KT Tunstall become the first player to appear in two of the Open finals during 2005, winning them both (of course). [If you do not get the "suddenly I see" reference, just ask anyone from the younger generation, or any pop music expert].

It is also the 3rd time he has won this particular Open in the last five stagings of the event, taking into consideration that it was not held between 1999 and 2001, and was also cancelled last year.

How good is this "god of the game"? Just browse through the table earlier in this edition of the BBQ to show how many players have such poor records against him, and this will explain how he wins so many events.

When I offered recently to score one of his games, I pointed out that he "always wins when I score", later realising that many, many people could say the same!

His progress during the day was fairly typical of the man. His first round match was against Phil Hawkins who is obviously still struggling with the eye problems that required an emergency operation earlier this year. A 12,000 break against "Predictor Extraordinaire" Dave May (see below) was followed by an 11,000 break against danger-man Mark James and then a top class quarterfinal against Geoff Jukes.

Kevin had notched over 18,000 in the first leg (although it was not recorded whether that was in one break or not) and then stood nervously as Geoff made just under 15k in reply. He obviously felt that he had to step up the pace in the semi-final against the man closest to him in the ranking list, Paul Sainsbury. Kevin made a fantastic 20,040 to set the standard but, Paul had already registered the best break of the day (22,270 against Gareth Lloyd in the 3rd round) and beaten two other dangerous contenders (Ray Sturgess and Harry Barbet) so they may have "thought it was not all over"...

...But "it was now", as Paul blew it at 8,000, later returning for another 10,000 when the going was a little tougher than tough.

The final pitted the master against Tony Walsh, another Reading player who has suffered major eye problems in recent years but can still usually progress to the latter stages of many competitions when the "lighting is right" for him. Kevin made another phenomenal 19,200 break and then gratefully accepted Tony's conceding gesture when he only made 8,920 in reply.

Nobody can say that Tony had it easy during the day. After ousting Charlie Cooper in the first round, Tony had to beat four potential winners of the event to qualify for the match against KT:

Richard Wooton and Chris Reeves, two of the new stars from Sussex, Steven Sheard and then the other Sheard in the semi-final.

Keith was reported to have "lost his rag" in the 1st leg of that game when the balls continued to stick in the alley coming down from the 50 hole, claiming that it "always happened to him" He also lost about 8k in the 2nd leg when time was running out anyway.

Keith had not had an easy run either, beating Chris Saville, Glenn Chubb, Phil Collins (a new name in the game to most but who has just been named as Wallingford's player-of-the-year which is obviously no mean achievement), and Bernie McCluskey. In that 4th round game, Keith made breaks of 18,560 and 12,270.

Bernie, who we rarely see in Opens these days, had made breaks of 14,470 and 18,060 against Dave Alder and 17,270 against Leon Beer before also fighting back to beat Pauline Withey.

Pauline won both top ladies' prizes, the highest break for the 5,540 effort she achieved by beating Gary Johnson (who always seems to get a "late entry" these days) in round two, and "furthest lady" for reaching round 3. Sue Atkins also won 2 games but lost out on count-back.

The rankings of seven of the last eight were: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10 and 33, probably the finest line-up in an Open quarterfinal since the amazing 1996 Northants Open, the statistics of which are well worth recalling here for those who have not been taking the BBQ for too long:

NOSTALGIA (1996 NORTHANTS OPEN) Excerpt from BBQ 27:

1. *7 of the 8 parts of the draw were won by the highest-ranked player in the section, only Tony Walsh failing in his section which was won by Bernie McCluskey.*

2. *6 of the top 9 in the rankings (Burrows, Sheard, Tunstall, Clark, Green and Farrelly) reached the last 8 and two of the other three (Sainsbury and Mariner) did not enter, so only Walsh missed out. Mick Lingham (13) and McCluskey (18) were the others who made it into the quarterfinals.*

3. *All quarterfinalists had previously won major events.*

4. *Six of the 8 had (at the time) won 10 All-England titles, 11 British Open Pairs titles, 8 Alternative Rules titles, 3 British Isles Open titles in Jersey, 22 various Opens in England, 2 Grand Prix Masters titles and 62 England caps.*

5. *It was also the highest-scoring National final at the time: John Burrows made 23,630 in the 1st leg, followed by Keith Sheard making 23,620 before leaving a split shot hanging over the 100 hole. Keith hit it but left both balls up, allowing John (the All-England champion at the time) to make the vital 530 to clinch it.*

6. *Sheard also made a 26,400 break in the last 16 match with Mark Brewster, which was, at the time, the highest break ever made in a national event.*

Alan Chaloner was the only "surprise" quarterfinalist. He wasn't even in the original draw but took the place of Ernie Jordan and then beat Dennis Atkins, last month's winner of the Bucks Open, in the first round. He then received a bye when both Caroline Retfalvi and Dawn Jordan failed to turn up for the first round. Dennis had been scheduled to play wife Sue, but Alan not only spoilt that idea but then had the cheek to beat Sue aswell. At least he saved Dennis from the same fate that Steve Mariner suffered in the Sussex Open a few years ago, i.e. beaten by the "better half".

There were, amazingly, no ranking movements in the top 26, Steven Sheard being the highest mover, from 33 to 27. And there were first ranking points for Kevin Pringle and Dave Tallack, both reaching the last 16 of an Open for the first time. Dave can count himself a little lucky as he had a bye in the first round and then narrowly beat Janet Burns by 170 points. Janet took the prize for "Best Berkshire Lady entrant".

Two of the top 1st round matches saw Geoff Jukes make a 15,300 break which proved just too much for Nigel Senior, and Paul Sainsbury comfortably beating Harry Barbet, who is fast becoming a regular visitor to most of our Opens, all the way from Jersey.

Chris Saville survived his 1st round defeat against Sheardy to beat Lee Radford by just 70 in the semi-final of the Plate, and then beat Dennis Atkins for those 2 extra ranking points.

BBQ Tipsters Derby: As most of the big names made it through to the last 8 this time, the Tipsters' scores were the best so far. Glenn Chubb still managed only 2 correct predictions, with Pete Sainsbury, Kevin Tunstall and Pete Farrelly scoring 4. Nigel Senior got 6 right, which is a world record, only Tony Woolvin and Dennis Atkins failing to make it a 100% score for our new TD. But the "gold medal" still goes to Dave May who scored 5 but claimed a bonus of 2 for correctly predicting both the winner and the runner-up.

FACTS PRINTED IN ITALICS ARE "PRE-BBQ" ANYONE CAPABLE OF FILLING IN SOME OF THE BLANKS?

A (mainly) young Sussex team have won their first County Championship title since 1981, ending a 5-year run of success by the all-star Oxfordshire team. Jim Millward was the exception agewise, but despite him thinking he may have been, he wasn't in the team the last time Sussex won it. For information only, the team then was Colin Smith, John Thayre, John Sullivan, Jeff Dobson, Roger Taylor, Tony Franks and Terry Race, with Colin Peskett non-playing captain and Mick Ingram and Steve Merriott on the bench.

They finished the day 6 points clear of Oxon after storming home with two 7-0 victories over Kent A and Hampshire. It did not look as if that would be the case when Sussex lost their first match 4-3 against Oxon, but it could not be regarded as a surprise as they have never beaten them in eight meetings since BBQ records began in 1991.

It could have been a disadvantage for Oxon as they were given the initial breaks in all three of the initial games, especially as many considered some of the tables were a "little dodgy". However, although Richard Wooton beat his nemesis Pete Farrelly to inflict the latter's first ever defeat in three seasons in Oxfordshire colours, Kevin Tunstall and Steven Sheard won the last two legs which were played concurrently, both with 10,000 scores, to give the holders a fine start to the day.

As Sussex sat out the next series, Oxon had a chance of pulling away but lost a 3-2 lead when Kevin and Steven missed out to Paul Yeo and Bill Trinder respectively. The advantage edged even further towards Sussex when they managed to beat Berkshire 5-2 while Oxon were only beating Kent 4-3 with Alan Farra beating Kevin easily.

Oxon knew it was not going to be easy now, but did their best in their final game by beating Hampshire 5-2. It would have been better if Farrelly could have overcome the determined Jack Lockyer. They then thought they would have to wait to see if they could hold on to their title, but it

soon became apparent that they were "whistling in the wind" as Sussex were now showing their class as a team. Sussex were currently busy completing a whitewash of Kent, so only needed two legs against Hampshire to take the trophy.

When all three initial legs were won by Jim, Barry Holt and Steve Mariner, all with 8,000 plus scores, the success of the day was assured. The three young guns (oh, and Mark James) completed the 7-0 result for good measure.

At the death, Hampshire were a little unlucky to be uniquely relegated for the second year in succession. Reprieved this year when Buckinghamshire inexplicably decided not to take their place in the 1st division due to player holidays, they were just pipped for survival when Kent managed to take the three legs against Berkshire.

Mark James and Steve Mariner both remained unbeaten on the day, and Mark Turner was the only player from outside the Sussex side to do so, despite his highest score being only 6,480.

Keith Sheard not only topped the averages but also made the highest break, 18,860 against the hapless Tony Webster. Most people think that Keith wins this prize about every other year, whereas he has only won it TWICE before in BBQ history.

Kent and Northants each sent two teams for the first time, helping to make the day a bigger and better event, although it caused poor old Chris Saville to hump four tables up from Kent, and this necessity took its toll on the financial balance sheet of the day. Many people privately expressed their surprise to see Northants especially able to send an extra team after they had previously declared that they were not going to field even one team. It had been claimed that the reason Northants had initially decided to withdraw was because they were unhappy at the excessive travelling involved, only to play TWO matches during a disjointed day.

The former Tournament Director would like to point out that every team has **always** played a minimum of THREE matches in the County Championships (see the table of results later in this BBQ for proof if required). The only time there had been only three teams in the 1st or 2nd divisions was 2000 when Cambridge failed to appear and, on that occasion, Surrey, Berks and Hants played each other twice. (NOTE: Northants were in the 1st Div on that occasion, so were not involved anyway.) They must be getting confused with the Inter-Area event where only 7 teams were involved since the withdrawal of Cambridge. We rectified this by accepting Portsmouth into the Association (two groups of 4) and so assure every team of 3 matches even if they did not qualify for the final. It was Northants who still insisted on withdrawing, forcing us into having uneven groups of 3 and 4. Their original reasons for withdrawing from the County Championships therefore are not borne out by the facts, but we all welcome them back into the event, and into the first division in 2006.

Jean Over was unquestionably the outstanding player on the day and seemed certain to take her 2nd All-England title after an unbelievable gap of 22 years, but was trapped on such a tough breaking table in the final that she totally succumbed to outsider Jane Carless from Reading.

Not trying to take anything away from Jane as she kept her nerve marvellously in the last few seconds of the 2nd leg to win by just 460 points, but Jean's form in her group, which was much, much tougher than Jane's, suggested that she was now back to the best form that made her one of the most feared lady players in the 1980's.

Jean beat off challenges from Diana Welburn, Josie Pitt and Sue Atkins, all capable of winning the title themselves, with an incredible average of 8,300 per leg, but could not get to grips with the amount of left hand side she probably needed to get the break in the final. She has to be satisfied with the fact that the day lifts her from No.10 to No.5 in the ladies' rankings.

But Jane, whose highest leg score during the day was 4,140, is now at a career high of No.3. Well done Jane!

Fittingly, after Sussex A and Oxfordshire A had both beaten Surrey A 4-1 and Kent 3-2 in turn, it all came down to the deciding match between the two top teams.

Sussex had the break in both opening legs, but it came out 1-1 with Michelle Baden making a 4,780 break to beat No.1 Pauline Withey and Jenny Parsons taking out Kim Beeching. Jean Over put Sussex ahead with an 8,200 score against Oxfordshire's current Ladies Champion Sue Atkins which also included a 4,170 break. Oxfordshire started celebrating as both Jane Wood and Jenny Abbott seemed well on the way to winning both remaining legs, with County Secretary Kevin Tunstall even breaking off from his own All-England Individual final to embrace Jane on the next table.

But whereas Jane kept her 5,300 break (only 10 short of the best of the day) to beat Bella Stoner (despite Bella getting a 4,890 break herself), Jenny pegged her 6,000+ winning break to allow Sue Mariner a narrow 1,450 – 1,090 victory. It turned round Sue's day as she had lost her other two matches and only averaged 1,547 to finish 40th of the 46 competitors in the championships, which must be her worst ever position, considering her undoubted class. The strength of the team is shown, however, by the other players all finishing in the top 8 in the averages.

Michelle, who finished top of the pile, had also made the highest break in the division, 5,310 against Janie Macoy and was one of only two players in the first division to remain unbeaten, the other being Kent's Diana Welburn.

Kevin Tunstall has won a record FIFTH All-England Individual Championship.

The first was in 1980. Incomparable achievement? Yes.

He won through a tough group despite losing his opening match (against Barry Radford), just as he did in the 2003 Grand Prix group, and he went on to win that title aswell.

The remaining group matches gave him very little trouble as he notched up big score after big score to make sure that, if it came to aggregate scores on count-back, he was likely to be the one to progress to the final. His final tally was more than double everyone else.

The other group looked to be going the way of Tony Walsh after he beat Barry Holt and Phil Buckle in his first two games, but Jason Neal became the spanner in the works when he made a 14,450 break to beat Tony in the last match. So it all came down to aggregates and, with Barry Holt having made scores of 11,470 and 13,800 a few minutes earlier against Phil, it was the Sussex man who went through by 7,810 points. Jason even pipped Tony for 2nd place in the group which attracted extra ranking points.

Barry crazily totally under-hit the first shot of the first leg in the final and, although Kevin skimmed the 100 hole to reply with only 980, the underdog could only make 710 on his 2nd visit.

Once again Kevin failed to take advantage with a score of only 90. Barry made another 20 but that was to be Barry's last chance. Normal service was resumed after a six-minute "breakdown" and Kevin's break was 13,660, which was converted to yet another title when he opened the 2nd leg with another 6,250.

Barry made himself feel better with efforts of 6,550 and 2,710 but all to no avail.

Neither Kevin Tunstall nor his Merry Men in the Team Championships for the first time since 1998, but, no matter, the Oxfordshire team champions still walked away with the title for the 5th time in the last eight years.

But this time, it was the Keith Sheard and Pauline Withey inspired team from Morris Motors Social Club, Oxford, who beat the Surrey representatives from the South Park Constitutional Club from Redhill, rather quaintly named considering Dave Constable was in the team.

Pauline won the toss for choice of breaks in the final and decided to make the 2nd and 4th legs her "bankers", but although Keith Sheard did the business with 12,750, son Steven gave Surrey Individual champion Laurie Roberts the chance to make it "even-Stevens". Ray Sturgess, however, proved he was back to his best by beating Vernon Sparkes against the break to give Pauline the opportunity of clinching the title before the 5th leg started. Unfortunately, her possible winner for the 200 last ball shot felled the black pin and the final was extended to the timed-break deciding leg.

With the rarely-used rules explained, Andy Finn set about the target of playing for at least 8.5 minutes to bring the rule into action. But, after only 2,330 points, he was off and it was all over when Kevin Godfrey made 9,320 in reply.

Pauline's opponent, Jim Greensted, remained unbeaten in all his five games with Kevin Godfrey (4), Ernie Jordan (4) and Jim Millward (3) the only others in the tournament. Jim also topped the averages.

In their group, Morris Motors had looked likely winners once they took a 3-0 lead against the star-studded Stadium team in the opening match. But the Sussex champions, basically the same team who won this event in 1995, 1996 and 1997, were given some hope when Mark James beat Ray and Jim Millward beat Keith against the break.

After beating Kelsey Arms, Tunbridge Wells 4-1, the Oxford side still needed to beat another powerful team, Caversham's WMC, to qualify. Three 5-figure scores in the first three legs by Ray, Steven and Pauline were just what the doctor ordered.

Group 2 was less keenly contested with the South Park Constitutional Club winning their first three games 4-1. After their break, they succumbed 3-2 to Langstone Harbour Fishing Assoc but it was too late by then.

Some of those present were introduced to a "famous" name from the website. 16-year-old "Sith" Johnny George appeared for the White Swan for an introduction into the big time, and produced a fine performance after a nervy start, winning two of his four games with 5,500 scores, but JUST missing out on his coveted first ranking points. The brash youth turned out to be a very quiet and unassuming teenager.

Sue Mariner dropped out of the team after Stadium's first match to concentrate on the Special Ladies Open (where she lost in the quarter-finals to Jean Over), but with "old man" Steve losing all three of his games, it was not a good day for the family.

You could say the same for Chris Saville! No tables to hump about this time, but Chris had a bit of a nightmare, scoring only a total of 3,030 in his three games, but, in his defence, he was drawn to play three of the players who ended up in the top six in the averages.

But also thanks to the new Tournament Director who quickly re-scheduled a few games to allow Pauline and Sue Mariner to play in BOTH this and the National Team Championships for the first time.

Yes, it was a controversial decision which could have created an enormous problem in the later stages of the day. As it was, the only problem was that it extended the day by 25 minutes as Pauline was involved in both finals. She had to play a vital leg in the Team final and had a chance to clinch the title for her Morris Motors team 3-1 if she had potted the final 200 and then switch to individual mode to play a two-leg match against Jean Over.

She lost the toss in the final, only went off with 1,890 but won the first leg by over 3,000. Pauline managed to hold on for the championship despite a spirited comeback by Jean in the 2nd leg.

Jean was unlucky again as, just as in the All-England final a few weeks earlier, she played extremely well all day but failed to get to grips with the table used for the final. She captured the highest break here, too, making a 7,790 to oust Sue Mariner in the last eight. If it is any consolation, Jean is now up to No.5 in the rankings and Sue Mariner is up to No.2
