Burrows lost the 2nd leg when Nigel Bisson made the top Jersey break (5,480) which never looked like catching John's 15,910 from the 1st leg. Other breaks: McCluskey, 17,130; Sainsbury, 16,860; Tinto, 15,710; Burrows, 13,970. Other noteworthy Jersey break; S. Ahier, 5,030.

Charlie Wheeler (Butchers), who doesn't know him, disposed of Albert Parham 3,150 - 1,500 and Reading were 3 games up..... and it looked like being a grand slam when Sid Irving beat Fred Barrett 3,470 - 1,270.

Even Arthur Boyd looked chuffed, but Abingdon's Tommy Burnham saved the North Berks face with a fast scoring win over Arthur Holland (Dove) 7,500 - 1,150 including the best break of the evening, 4,140. But as Charlie said, Reading only need 2 wins to go through!"

**NEWS FROM NORTHANTS** Final league table in Division 1 of the Northants League saw Rushden Snooker Centre "A" take the title at the first attempt, although it was basically the same team who had taken the title seven times previously at the Compasses and Waggon and Horses, also in Rushden.
