THE RANKINGS an explanation

By popular demand, here is a full explanation of how the Ranking Points system will work from January 1993. There are a few minor amendments to the original system published in BBQ No 1 in March 1991.

UP-DATING FACTOR. Ranking points gained in 1991 will be withdrawn at the end of 1993. Those gained in 1992 will go the following year. This keeps the rankings up to date as it keeps the system relevant to no more than three years' achievements. A "provisional list" will appear in October 1993, so let's see if any major changes are likely to take place.

LADIES RANKINGS. Ladies gaining ranking points in OPEN events will receive HALF those allocated as above which will then be added to those won in LADIES ONLY events. LADIES INTERNATIONAL MATCHES, LADIES COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS, and LADIES ALL-ENGLAND INDIVIDUALS will attract ranking points as per the equivalent Open events, but score bonuses will begin at 5,000 in all events. The LADIES BRITISH OPEN will attract similar ranking points as the Grand Prix events.
